Welland Warlords 7 Six Nations Rebels 4

OHSWEKEN - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels find the Best-of-Five Western Conference Semi-Finals series tied at 1-1 following a 7-4 loss to the Welland Warlords Sunday night before move than an estimated 400 lacrosse fans at the Welland Arena.

Game three of the semi-finals goes Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena in Ohsweken with an 8:00 PM start.

The Rebels started Cody VanEvery in goal while Connor Danko started for the Warlords.

As in game 1, Welland jumped out to an early lead as Andy Tober opened the scoring 5:44 into the first period. Rebels Jeremy Johns tied the game 1:30 later. The Warlords Jordy Daradick restored their lead at 8:56 and Tyler Warren added to it at the 12:00 mark.

Daradick netted his second of the game at 16:39 for a 4-1 Warlords lead. Rebels leading playoff scorer, Kraig Maracle cut the lead in half with a goal in the final minute of play in the first period.

Six Nations outshot Welland 15-12 in the opening 20 minutes.

The Warlords MacKenzie Abbott would score the eventual game winner just 45 seconds into the second frame. Warlords Daradick would complete his hat-trick at 2:53 of the second period. The Rebels coaches had seen enough and replaced starter, VanEvery with backup, Warren Hill. Rebels Maracle would fire home his second of the game at 15:41 on the power play as Welland would take a 6-3 lead to the third period.

Both teams would have 14 shots apiece on goal.

Rebels rookie, Vaughn Harris scored his 1st career playoff goal at 7:03. In the final minute of play Warlords, Dane Hansen rounded out the scoring with a goal into an empty net before Rebels goalie, Hill could make it back to the goal.

Six Nations outshot Welland 12-11 in the third to hold a 41-37 edge for the entire contest.

The Warlords were led by Jordy Daradick with a three-goal performance. Tyler Warren (1G, 1A), MacKenzie Abbott (1G, 1A), Josh Eldridge (2A), Kevin Floris (2A) and Thomas O'Malley (2A) contributed a pair points each. Single Warlords points were by Andy Tober (1G), Dane Hansen (1G), Robert Wormald (1A), Tyler Tanguay (1A) and Shane Pollock (1A).

Rebels were led by Kraig Maracle with a three-point (2G, 1A) night. Jeremy Johns (1G, 1A) contributed a pair of points. Single Rebels points were by Vaughn Harris (1G), Russell Longboat (1A), Kyle Isaacs (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A), Chadd Murphy (1A), Wayne VanEvery (1A) and goalie, Cody VanEvery (1A).
