Owen Sound NorthStars 7 Six Nations Rebels 6

OWEN SOUND - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels suffered their second consecutive hard-fought loss Sunday afternoon at the Harry Lumley Bayshore Arena. This time it was a 7-6 decision to the Owen Sound NorthStars.

The Rebels started Cody VanEvery in goal while Tom Watkins started for the NorthStars.

The Rebels must have had a bit of jet lag of a 3-hour bus trip to Owen Sound as the NorthStars would do all the scoring in the opening 20 minutes on goals by NorthStars captain Jordan Smith, Robbie Hellyer and Nathan Barfoot (power play). Both teams would have 11 shots on goal in the first period.

The Rebels got some jump back in the middle frame as rookie Kyle Isaacs got them going at 5:09. Kraig Maracle would add a pair of power play goals to tie the game 3-3 by the 14:50 mark. Hellyer's 2nd of the game would give the NorthStars the lead again with a power play goal 64 seconds later. The Rebels Jeremy Johns got that goal back with a shorthanded effort less than two minutes later. Just 37 seconds later Jordan McMillen gave Owen Sound a 5-4 lead heading into the 2nd intermission.

The Rebels outshot the NorthStars 16-10 in the middle frame.

In the third it looked like things might be going in the Rebels favour as Kraig Maracle completed his hat-trick to tie the game at 4:09. Jacob Crans added his 1st career Jr B goal at 9:03 to give the Rebels their 1st lead of the game. It was beginning to look like the Rebels would hold onto the 1-goal lead, however a Nathan Barfoot bounce shot rolled just over the goal-line to tie the game 6-6 with 5:13 remaining. Just when it looked like both teams were getting ready of overtime, Mike Quaid bounce a shot between the legs of Rebels goalie, VanEvery for the eventual game-winner with 2:45 remaining. Six Nations was unable to get a shot off in the final minute as the NorthStars held on for their 3rd win in a row and 4th in the last 5 games.

Six Nations outshot Owen Sound 15-11 in the third and 42-32 for the entire contest.

NorthStars goalie, Tom Watkins earned the game MVP honours with his 36 save performance or a .857 save % on the night. The Rebels 2009 All-star representative, Kraig Maracle was their game MVP.

Joining Maracle at the 2009 Jr B All-Star game will be Rebels defensive standout, Clark Robinson and goalie, Cody VanEvery.

The Rebels were led by Kraig Maracle with a four-point (3G, 1A) game. Jeremy Johns contributed a three-point (1G, 2A) effort. Jesse Staats added a pair of helpers. Single Rebels points were by Kyle Isaacs (1G), Jacob Crans (1G), Randy Martin (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A), Vaughn Harris (1A), Johnny Powless (1A), Carney Johnson (1A) and Ryley Johnson (1A).

NorthStars were led by Robbie Hellyer (2G, 3A) with a five-point game. Captain Jordan Smith had a four-point (1G, 3A) night. Nathan Barfoot had a three-point (1G, 2A) game. Jordan McMillen (1G, 1A) and Mike Quaid (1G, 1A) contributed a pair of points each. Single NorthStars points by Hayden Smith (1A), Curtis Gibbons (1A), Mitch McArthur (1A) and goalie Tom Watkins (1A).

The Rebels host Far West Division leading, Windsor AKO Fratmen Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 PM start.

Owen Sound will travel to the Sleeman Centre for a battle against the Guelph Regals Friday night for an 8:00 PM start.
