Six Nations Rebels 13 Hamilton Bengals 4

HAMILTON – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels have made it to the end of the first half of the 2010 OLA Jr B Regular season with a perfect 10-and-0 record following a 13-4 win over the Hamilton Bengals Sunday afternoon at the Dave Andreychuk Arena.

This was the 15th meeting between the Rebels and Bengals since 2006 with Six Nations winning the last 13 games in a row after the Bengals had won their first two meetings.

The Bengals started **John McNamara** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Klayton Maracle** between the pipes.

The Rebels **Vaughn Harris** opened the scoring with a shorthanded effort 6:09 into the contest. A couple of Rebels power play goals by **Carney Johnson** (6:54) and **Chris Attwood** (8:46) made it a 3-0 Six Nations lead. Rebels rookie, **Lucas Smith** would notch his first career Jr B goal on a solo effort at 17:27 for a 4-0 Six Nations lead after 20 minutes of play.

The Rebels outshot the Bengals 16-11 in the opening 20-minutes.

In the middle frame, the Rebels put the game out of reach for the Bengals as **Carney Johnson** (2nd of the game & Game-Winning-Goal), **Torrey VanEvery**, **Wayne VanEvery** and **Jesse Johnson** made it an 8-0 score by the 6:48 mark of the middle stanza. Bengals coaching staff opted to change goalies at this point as out went **McNamara** and in went **Jayson Gibson**. The Rebels rookie, **Jacob Bomberry** greeted **Gibson** with his first of two on the night. The Bengals finally got the scoreboard with a power play by **Darryl Waud** at 12:38. Rebels **Vaughn Harris** (2nd of the game) added a shorthanded marker at 14:06. Bengals **George Magur** converted a turnover at center to make it a 10-2 score 16:15. Rebels **Harris** completed his hat-trick at 17:54 for an 11-2 lead after 40-minutes of action.

The Rebels outshot the Bengals 26-9 in the middle frame.

In the third period, the Bengals opened with a couple of power play goals by **Alex Aquin** at 1:24 and 3:14 to make it an 11-4 score. However that would be the final Hamilton goal on the night as Rebels **Chris Attwood** connected with a man-advantage effort at 7:44. **Jacob Bomberry** (2nd of the night) completed the scoring on the night at the 13:00 mark.

The Bengals outshot the Rebels 18-8 in the third period, however it was Six Nations finishing with a 50-38 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were **Chris Attwood** (2G, 4A) and his 6-point night. **Vaughn Harris** (3G, 2A) and **Jeremy Johns** (5A) added a five-point night. **Jacob Bomberry** (2G, 2A) contributed a 4-point game. **Wayne VanEvery** (1G, 2A) and **Torrey VanEvery** (1G, 2A) finished with a 3-point game on the night. Rebels **Carney Johnson** (2G), **Tony Doxtator** (2A) and **Brandon Montour** (2A) added two-points each. Single Rebels points were by **Jesse Johnson** (1G), captain **Jason Johns** (1A) and Rebels Game MVP **Klayton Maracle** (1A).

The Bengals were led by captain, **Zach Hill** with three helpers. Bengals Game MVP **Alex Aquin** (2G) and **Matt Worlidge** (2A) added a pair of points each. Single Bengals points were by **Darryl Waud** (1G), **George Magur** (1G), **Chris Buswell** (1A) and **Eric Wales** (1A).

The Rebels return to the friendly confines of Gaylord Powless Arena when they host the Sarnia Pacers Friday night for an 8:00 PM start.

The Bengals host Niagara Thunderhawks next Sunday afternoon for a 4:00 PM tilt at the Dave Andreychuk Arena.
