Six Nations Rebels Ready for 2nd half of OLA Jr B Regular season

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels have been perfect for the first half of the 2010 OLA Jr B Regular season with a perfect 10-and-0 record, now begins the tough journey through the 2nd half of the regular season as the Rebels ready for their 2nd three-game weekend of the season.

The Rebels host Sarnia Friday night, travel to Windsor Saturday and host the Guelph Regals Sunday night to cap the weekend off.

The journey begins Friday night when they host the Sarnia Pacers at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 PM start. The Pacers are currently 4-and-8 and are coming off the wrong end of a 9-7 decision to Niagara Thunderhawks last Sunday night in Sarnia.

The Rebels and Pacers have met 19 times to date with Six Nations holding a 12-7 advantage. The Rebels have won their last four meetings with the Pacers last win coming on May 21, 2005 which was an 8-4 win in Sarnia. The Rebels and Pacers have met once in the playoffs back in 2002 when the Pacers enjoyed a 3-game sweep of Six Nations in the opening round.

The Rebels are currently led by Wayne VanEvery (22G, 24A) with his 46 points, Chris Attwood (17G, 27A) has 44 points, 16 year-old Jacob Bomberry (19G, 18A) has 37 points, Vaughn Harris (18G, 9A) is next with 27 points, J. Quinn Powless (3G, 23A) has served his 3-game suspension, is cleared to play. Torrey VanEvery (8G, 16A) and Jesse Johnson (9G, 11A) round out the Rebels 20 points or more in the first 20 games this season.

Sarnia has two players with 20 points or more in Jimmy Purves (17G, 16A) with 33 points and team captain, Riley Thompson (12G, 13A) for 25 points. Purves also leads the Pacers in penalty minutes with 50 to date.

Saturday night the Rebels travel to the Forest Glade Arena to play the Windsor Clippers for a 7:00 PM faceoff. The Clippers are the continuance of the Windsor AKO Fratmen which joined the Jr B league back in 2003. The two teams have met 8 times since 2003 with the Rebels winning four games, Windsor claiming three victories and last year the teams tied 6-6 back on June 12th.

Six Nations and Windsor have met 3 times in the post-season with the Rebels winning all three of those series. In 2005 the Rebels took the opening round in four games. In 2007 Six Nations swept Windsor in the Conference Finals on route to the organizations' 2nd Founders Cup Champions. In 2008 the Rebels took that Conference Semi-Final series in 4 games on their way to Back-to-Back Founders Cup titles.

The Clippers are led by Brett Hickey (17G, 15A) with 32 points, Alex Seguin (5G, 19A) added 24 points, Corey Burchell (13G, 9A) and Jeff Rivait (12G, 10A) have 22 points each.

Sunday night the Rebels will be back at the Gaylord Powless Arena to host the Guelph Regals for a 7:00 PM start. The Rebels have met the Regals 20 times since 1997 with Six Nations winning 17 of those contests including the first 12 games. The Regals ended the drought in 2005 with a 9-6 win at the Gaylord Powless Arena on April 29th. Guelph last won against Six Nations on April 30, 2006 with a 12-11 overtime decision. The Rebels enjoyed their 1st shutout of an opponent against Guelph on June 4, 2000 when Ryan MacNaughton closed the gates for a 15-0 win at the Gaylord Powless Arena. The Rebels and Regals have met once in the OLA Jr B playoffs back in 1997 with the Rebels winning is 6 games of the 1st round of the playoffs. Of course the Rebels and Regals met in the 2008 Founders Cup final with the Rebels claiming their 3rd national crown 8-7 at the Guelph Entertainment and Sports Centre.

The Regals are led by Mike Cazzola (9G, 19A) with 28 points. David Godin (8G, 15A) with 23 points and Jordan Godin (8G, 11A) adds 19 points for Guelph. The Regals played Elora Mohawks Saturday night.

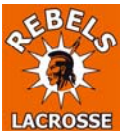
