Six Nations Rebels 8 Windsor Clippers 6

WINDSOR – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels are a perfect dozen after 12 games of the 2010 OLA Jr B Regular season following an 8-6 triumph over the Windsor Clippers Saturday night before 301 fans at the Forest Glade Arena.

This was the 9th meeting between the Rebels and Clippers since 2003 with Six Nations winning their 5th game of the series while Windsor has won 3 of the contest and 1 game played to a draw.

The Clippers started **Erik McLaren** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Don Alton** between the pipes.

The Rebels **Wayne VanEvery** opened the scoring at the 16:30 mark of the opening period. However the Clippers exploded for 3 goals in the final minute of the opening 20 minutes of play as **Tyler McDowall** scored at 19:10 with **Brett Hickey** finding the back of the mesh twice (19:35 & 19:58) for a 3-1 Clippers lead heading to the first intermission. The Rebels outshot the Clippers 18-14 in the opening 20-minutes.

In the middle frame was all Rebels as they scored all three markers as **Jacob Bomberry** (7:49), **Wayne VanEvery** (12:11 and 2nd of the game) and **Chris Attwood** (13:09) gave the visitors a 4-3 lead after 40 minutes of play.

The Rebels outshot the Clippers 23-11 in the middle frame.

In the third period, the Clippers **Justin Wilson** scored an unassisted breakaway goal at 1:17 to even the score at 4-4.

Just 69 seconds the Clippers regained the lead as **Nick Dolik** netted his 1st goal of the season. **Wayne VanEvery** completed his hat-trick at 5:12 to tie the game at 5-5. Rebels **Vaughn Harris** gave the visitors a lead they would not relinquish the made the remainder of the contest at 6:49. **Wayne VanEvery** connected with his 4th goal of the game and the eventual Game-Winning-Goal at 13:04 for a 7-5 Six Nations lead. With the Clippers goalie, **McLaren** on the bench in favour of an extra attacker for the final minute of play, **Tyler McDowall** fired a shot that missed the net which rebounded off the end boards to find the ball bouncing all the way to the Clippers empty net at 19:15. The goal was accredited to Rebels captain, **Jason Johns** as he was the closest defender to the shooter at that time. However, the Clippers did not give up as **Alex Seguin** scored a power play marker with 37 seconds remaining to round out the scoring. The Rebels outshot the Clippers 17-12 in the third period to finishing with a 58-37 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels led by **Wayne VanEvery** (4G, 1A) with a 5-point effort. **Chris Attwood** (1G, 2A) added a 3-point performance. **Vaughn Harris** (1G, 1A), captain **Jason Johns** (1G, 1A), **Jesse Johnson** (2A) and **Stuart Martin** (2A) finished with 2-points each on the night. Single Rebels points were by **Jacob Bomberry** (1G), **Rodd Squire** (1A), **J. Quinn Powless** (1A), **Jeremy Johns** (1A) and Rebels Game MVP goalie **Don Alton** (1A).

The Clippers were led by **Tyler McDowall** (1G, 2A) and **Devin Humphrey** (3A) with 3-point nights each. Clippers leading scorer, **Brett Hickey** (2G), **Nick Dolik** (1G, 1A) and **Alex Seguin** (1G, 1A) finished with 2-point games. Single Clippers points were by **Justin Wilson** (1G), **John Nowicki** (1A) and **Lucas Brouillard** (1A).

The Rebels host the Guelph Regals Sunday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena for a 7:00 PM start.

The Clippers will host the Sarnia Pacers at the Forest Glade Arena for a Tuesday night battle with an 8:00 PM start.
