Six Nations Rebels face tough South West Division Rivals this Weekend

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels and their perfect Bakers' Dozen records (13-and-0) are on the line this weekend when they face two South West Divisional foes, the Welland Warlords and the Oakville Buzz who will be taking a shot at ending the Rebels undefeated streak.

The Rebels host Welland Friday night then travel to down the 403 corridor Sunday night to battle the Oakville Buzz.

Friday night they host the Welland Warlords at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 PM start. The Warlords currently sit in 2nd-place in the division with a current record of 9-and-4. Welland is coming off of an 8-3 win over the Wallaceburg Red Devils last Saturday night at the Welland Arena.

The Rebels and Warlords have met 23 times since 2001 with Six Nations holding a 19-3-1 advantage. The Rebels and Warlords have met once in the playoffs back last year when the Rebels won the Western Conference Semi-Final series in a tough 5-game series.

The Rebels are currently led by OLA Jr B league leading scorer, Wayne VanEvery (35G, 32A) with his 67 points, Chris Attwood (22G, 39A) has 59 points to sit 3rd in league scoring, 16 year-old Jacob Bomberry (24G, 26A) with 50 points is 6th in league scoring, J. Quinn Powless (5G, 33A) has 38 points while Vaughn Harris (22G, 15A) with 37 points to round out the top 5 Rebels. Torrey VanEvery (10G, 16A) and Jeremy Johns (8G, 18A) have 26 points each while assistant captain, Jesse Johnson (10G, 15A) round out the Rebels 20 points or more in the first 13 games this season.

Welland is being lead by Jordie Daradick (19G, 24A) with 43 points to sit 12th in OLA Jr B scoring. Dylan Gatt (10G, 21A) has 31 points. Six Nations Arrows-Express draft pick, Josh Eldridge (13G, 13A) and Tyler Warren (8G, 18A) have 26 points each. Thomas O'Malley leads the Warlords in penalty minutes with 62 to date.

Sunday night the Rebels travel to the Glen Abbey Rec Centre for a 7:00 PM faceoff against the Oakville Buzz. The Buzz currently sit in 3rd-place of the South West Division with an 8-and-5 record, just two points behind the Welland Warlords. The two teams have met 6 times during the regular season since 2001 with the Rebels winning all six regular season games, including the Rebels 12-10 win earlier this season on May 2nd at the Gaylord Powless Arena.

The Rebels edged the Buzz in a tough 5-game first round series of the 2009 playoffs.

The Buzz are led by Patrick Corbett (20G, 21A) with 41 points, Dylan Gilbert (8G, 18A) added 26 points, Bryan Cole (14G, 11A) and captain Braden Gallant (11G, 14A) have 25 points each. Dan Lomas (14G, 7A) and Tyler Albrecht (8G, 13A) have 21 points to date.
