Six Nations Rebels 8 Welland Warlords 6

WELLAND – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels made it 18 wins in 18 starts with a thrilling edge of your seat 8-6 win over the Welland Warlords Sunday night before 708 spectators at the Welland Arena. The win clinches the Western Conference title for the Rebels which ensure the home floor advantage throughout the Western Conference playoffs.

This was the 25th regular season meeting between the Rebels and Warlords since 2001 with Six Nations winning their 21st game of the series with one game tied.

The Warlords started **Conner Danko** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Don Alton** between the pipes.

The Rebels **J. Quinn Powless** opened the scoring at 3:06. The Warlords **Tyler Tanguay** tied the game with a shorthanded marker at 4:21. However, **J. Quinn Powless** netted his second goal of the period at the 10 minute mark for a 2-1 Rebels lead after 20 minutes of action.

Welland held a 10-9 edge in shots during the 1st period.

In the middle frame, the Warlords leading scorer, **Jordie Daradick** scored a power play goal at 10:01. The Rebels would take 3-2 lead to the dressing room as **Torrey VanEvery** scored with five seconds left in the 2nd period.

The Rebels were outshot the Warlords 15-12 in the middle frame.

The third period was all action starting with a shorthanded goal by Warlords **Dylan Gatt** at 3:42. On the same penalty, the Rebels **Chris Attwood** netted a power play marker at 4:11. The Warlords **Tyler Warren** tied the game 43 seconds later. Only to have Rebels **Vaughn Harris** score a pair (6:20 & 8:20) with the second being a power play goal for a 6-4 lead. However Warlords sharp shooter, **Jordie Daradick** would add a pair of power play markers (10:34 & 14:40) for a 6-6 tie. Rebels **Jeremy Johns** would net the eventual Game-Winning-Goal with 4:59 remaining on the clock. Rebels Game MVP, **Jeremy Johns** would seal the Rebels victory with an insurance goal at 17:29.

The Rebels outshot the Warlords 21-18 in the third period, however the Warlords finished with a 43-42 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by **Chris Attwood** (1G, 4A) with a 5-point performance. **Vaughn Harris** (2G, 2A) contributed a 4-point effort. Rebels Game MVP-**Jeremy Johns** (2G, 1A) and **J. Quinn Powless** (2G, 1A) finished with 3-points each. **Torrey VanEvery** (1G, 1A) and **Jacob Bomberry** (2A) both had 2-point nights. Single Rebels points were by **Alex Martin** (1A), **Carney Johnson** (1A) and **Johnson Jimerson** (1A).

The Warlords were led by **Jordie Daradick** (3G) and **Tyler Tanguay** (1G, 2A) finished with 3-point games. **Tyler Warren** (1G, 1A), **Cameron Seneca** (2A), **Craig Attwood** (2A) and goalie **Connor Danko** (2A) contributed a pair of points. Single Warlords points were by **Dylan Gatt** (1G), **Thomas O'Malley** (1A) and **Paul Gardner** (1A).

It will also be Fan Appreciation when the Rebels play their final regular season home game as they host the Oakville Buzz Friday night for an 8:00 PM faceoff at the Gaylord Powless Arena.

The Warlords travel to the Nichols Recreation Centre Saturday night for a game against the London Blue Devils with a 7:00 PM faceoff.
