Six Nations Rebels 13 St. Catharines Spartan Warriors 7

ST. CATHARINES – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels moved to within one win of winning the Western Conference Quarter-Final Best-of-Five series with a 13-7 win over the St. Catharines Spartans Sunday night at the hot and sticky Merrittion Lions Arena.

The Rebels also took the series opener Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena with a 10-4 win.

The Rebels have won two previous post-season series in 2001 and 2003.

The Spartan Warriors started **Gavin Lecky** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Donny Alton** between the pipes.

Once again the Spartans jumped out to an early 2-0 lead on goals by **Jake Ciaramella** and **Kyle Winterbottom** by the midway point of the opening period. **Jacob Bomberry** got the Rebels on the scoreboard at 11:04 with goalie Alton on the bench in favour of an extra-attacker. **Carney Johnson** tied the contest at 12:02. St. Catharines would grab a 3-2 lead with a power play goal by captain, **Drew Thomas**.

Both teams had 14 shots on goal for the 1st period.

The Rebels **Rodd Squire** would score a shorthanded goal 1:30 into the middle frame. Spartans **Shane Dunkley** made it 5-4 with a breakaway effort at 2:14. **Wayne VanEvery** added a power play maker and **Jesse Johnson** would give the Rebels their 1st lead of the contest five minutes into the period. Spartan regular season leading scorer, **Mike Melnychenko** tied the contest with a power play goal at 7:09. Rebels defender, **Rodd Squire** would net his 2nd shorthanded goal of the period at 13:36 to give the visitors a lead they would not relinquish. **Chris Attwood** would add a pair in the final five minutes of the 2nd period for an 8-5 Rebels lead after 40 minutes of play.

Rebels outshot the Spartans 19-13 in the second period.

The third period saw the Rebels **Vaughn Harris** extended their lead to 9-5 just 63 seconds into the 3rd period. **Wayne VanEvery** fired home his 2nd of the game at 5:51 for a 10-5 Rebels lead. St. Catharines **Kyle Potter** netted a goal at 8:20 only to have Rebels **Chris Attwood** fire home his hat-trick marker of the night at 10:22. Spartans **Jake Ciaramella** scored his 2nd of the game with 3:40 showing on the clock. Spartan coaches pulled their goalie **Lecky** in an attempt to kick start their offense. **Lecky** was replaced by **Cam Fowler** with 3:17 remaining in the contest. Rebels **Johnson Jimerson** would score into an empty net at 17:12 and **Rodd Squire** would also put the ball into the open net to complete his 1st career Jr B hat-trick.

The Rebels held a 16-12 edge in 3rd period shots to finished 49-39 for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by **Chris Attwood** (3G, 3A) enjoyed a 6-point night. **Rodd Squire** (3G), **Wayne VanEvery** (2G, 1A), **Jacob Bomberry** (1G, 2A) and **J. Quinn Powless** (3A) all had 3-point games. **Jesse Johnson** (1G, 1A), **Vaughn Harris** (1G, 1A) and **Jeremy Johns** (2A) enjoyed 2-point performances. Single Rebels points were by **Carney Johnson** (1G), **Johnson Jimerson** (1G), **Rhys Tansley** (1A) **Stuart Martin** (1A) and goalie, **Don Alton** (1A).

St. Catharines were lead by **Jake Ciaramella** (2G, 2A) with a four-point game. Captain **Drew Thomas** (1G, 1A), **Mike Melnychenko** (1G, 1A), **Kyle Winterbottom** (1G, 1A) and **Braden Handley** (2A) had two-points apiece. Single Spartan points were by **Shane Dunkley** (1G), **Kyle Potter** (1G), **Adam Dickson** (1A), **Kyle Rushton** (1A) and **T. J. Buck** (1A).

Game three of the series continues Wednesday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena in Ohsweken for an 8:00 PM faceoff.

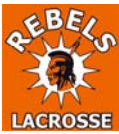
