Six Nations Rebels 7 Orangeville Northmen 4 (OT)

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels took game one of the Western Conference Semi-Finals 7-4, however the Rebels needed an extra 10-minutes to claim victory over the tough Orangeville Northmen Friday night before 694 fans at the Gaylord Powless Arena.

Game two of the series goes Monday night at the Tony Rose Arena with an 8:00 PM start.

The Rebels have won the only regular season meeting 9-5 back on April 28th in Orangeville. The two have met twice in the post-season with the Rebels sweeping 2003 while the Northmen swept in 2005.

The Northmen started **Michael Cregan** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Don Alton** between the pipes.

The Rebels sensational rookie of the year candidate, **Jacob Bomberry** opened the scoring with a power play marker at 3:56 into the contest. The Northmen leading scorer, **Dustin Caravello** tied the game at 5:37 with a power play goal of his own. **Bomberry** scored his second of the period 28 seconds later for a 2-1 Rebels lead that would carry over into the middle frame.

Rebels outshot the Northmen 14-10 in the first period.

The Rebels started the 2nd period with **Jacob Bomberry** netting his hat-trick at 7:43. Rebels **Chris Attwood** scored with a man advantage at 15:37 for a 4-1 Rebels lead. The Northmen would peck away at the lead as **Brandon Benn** scored at 16:54 and **Jayme Szabolcs** goal in the final minute made it 4-3 after 40 minutes of play.

Rebels were outshot by the Northmen 22-12 in the second period.

The third period saw only one goal scored as Northmen **Jayme Szabolcs** tied the game at 12:28 of the third period to force overtime.

Both teams had 12 shots on goal in 3rd period.

The overtime period was all Rebels as **Jacob Bomberry** netted the eventual Game-Winning-Goal at 1:09. **Chris Attwood** netted an insurance goal at 2:30 while **Jesse Johnson** sealed the final goal of the contest at 3:28. Despite pulling the Northmen goalie, **Cregan** in favour of an extra-attacker down the stretch the Northmen were able to get 1 shot on goal in the 10-minute extra-session.

Rebels outshot the Northmen 9-1 in the overtime session and 58-35.

The Rebels were led by **Jacob Bomberry** (4G, 1A) with a 5-point performance. **Vaughn Harris** (4A) added four helpers. **Chris Attwood** (2G, 1A) contributed 3-points. **Jesse Johnson** (1G, 1A) enjoyed a two-point night. Single Rebels points were by Rebels captain **Johnson Jimerson** (1A), **Torrey VanEvery** (1A), **Danny Vyse** (1A), **J. Quinn Powless** (1A), **Jeremy Johns** (1A), **Wayne VanEvery** (1A) and **Rodd Squire** (1A).

Orangeville were lead by **Jayme Szabolcs** (2G) and **Brendon Benn** (1G, 1A) with a two-goal game. Single Northmen points were by **Dustin Caravello** (1G), **Niall Caravello** (1A) and **Shane Snider** (1A).

Game two of the series goes Monday night at the Tony Rose Arena with an 8:00 PM start.

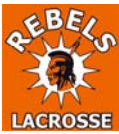
