## Six Nations Rebels 11 Orangeville Northmen 4

**OHSWEKEN** – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels advanced to the Western Conference Finals after defeating the Orangeville Northmen 11-4 Thursday night before 542 lacrosse fans at a hot and humid Gaylord Powless Arena.

The Rebels won the series opener 7-4 in overtime last Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup> at the Gaylord Powless Arena. This playoff series was the third meeting between the two squads with the Rebels sweeping 2003 while the Northmen swept in 2005.

The Northmen started **Curtis Rydall** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Don Alton** between the pipes.

The Rebels scored the first 3 goals of the contest as Rebels rookie of the year candidate, **Jacob Bomberry** scored 51 seconds after the opening faceoff. **Wayne VanEvery** made it 2-0 just 58 seconds later. **Bomberry** added his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the game at 4:28. Orangeville would get a power play goal from **Jake Thompson** at 6:16. Northmen **Andrew Stoner** made it a 1-goal game just 38 seconds later. Rebels would proceed to add three more goals from **Jesse Johnson** (9:22), **Wayne VanEvery** (14:23 and eventual Game-Winning-Goal) and **Jeremy Johns** (15:27) to force the Northmen coaching staff to change goalies from starter, **Rydall** to backup, **Michael Cregan** after the Rebels 6<sup>th</sup> goal of the first period.

The Rebels outshot the Northmen 23-15 in the first period. The Northmen would score twice to open the 2<sup>nd</sup> period as **Andrew Stoner** scored shorthanded at 2:54 and captain, **Dustin Caravello** found the netting just 54 seconds later to cut the lead down to 6-4. However, that would be all the offense for the rest of the night from Orangeville as Rebels **Wayne VanEvery** scored two more times at 5:58 and 16:22 for an 8-4 Rebels lead after 40 minutes of play.

Rebels outshot by the Northmen 22-13 in the second period.

The Rebels **Wayne VanEvery** scored his 5<sup>th</sup> goal of the game at 3:12 into the 3<sup>rd</sup> period. **Johnson Jimerson** would score into an empty net at 9:03. Rebels **Vaughn Harris** finished off the scoring at 15:36 for the 11-4 win. Rebels were outshot by the Northmen 14-11 in the third period however the Six Nations squad held a 56-42.

The Rebels were led by **Wayne VanEvery** (5G, 1A) with a 6-point game. **Jacob Bomberry** (2G, 1A), **Vaughn Harris** (1G, 2A), **Chris Attwood** (3A) and **J. Quinn Powless** (3A) all with 3-point performances. **Jeremy Johns** (1G, 1A), **Jesse Johnson** (1G, 1A) and **James Mt. Pleasant** (2A) contributed 2-point nights. Single Rebels points were by **Johnson Jimerson** (1G), **Jacob Crans** (1A), **Jason Johns** (1A), **Torrey VanEvery** (1A) and **Russell Longboat** (1A). Orangeville were lead by **Andrew Stoner** (2G), Northmen captain **Dustin Caravello** (1G, 1A) and **Brendon Benn** (2A) with a pair of points. Single Northmen points were by **Jake Thompson** (1G), **Cody McLeod** (1A), **James Shepherd** (1A) and **Tyler Symonds** (1A).

The Rebels will now face the Elora Mohawks in the Western Conference final. Date have yet to set.

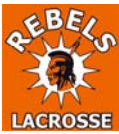
