Six Nations Rebels defeat Elora Mohawks to stay alive

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels came through with a hard fought 8-6 win over the Elora Mohawks to stay alive in the Best-of-Five Western Conference Finals Wednesday night at a standing room only Gaylord Powless Arena before 1,044 lacrosse fans. The Mohawks now lead the series 2-1. Game 4 will be Saturday night 7:00 PM at the Elora Community Centre.

The Rebels and Mohawks have met 19 times during the regular season since 1997 including the Rebels 8-5 win at the Elora Community Centre on June 9th. This the 6th post-season meetings with Elora holding a 3-2 series wins.

The Rebels started **Don Alton** in goal while the Mohawks started **Ricky McGarr** in goal.

The Mohawks **Mark Pfohl** opened the scoring just 2:06 into the contest. **Jake Weidner**

made it 2-0 Elora. **Jeremy Johns** got the Rebels on the scoreboard with 91 seconds left in the first period. Both teams had 13 shots on goal in the 1st period.

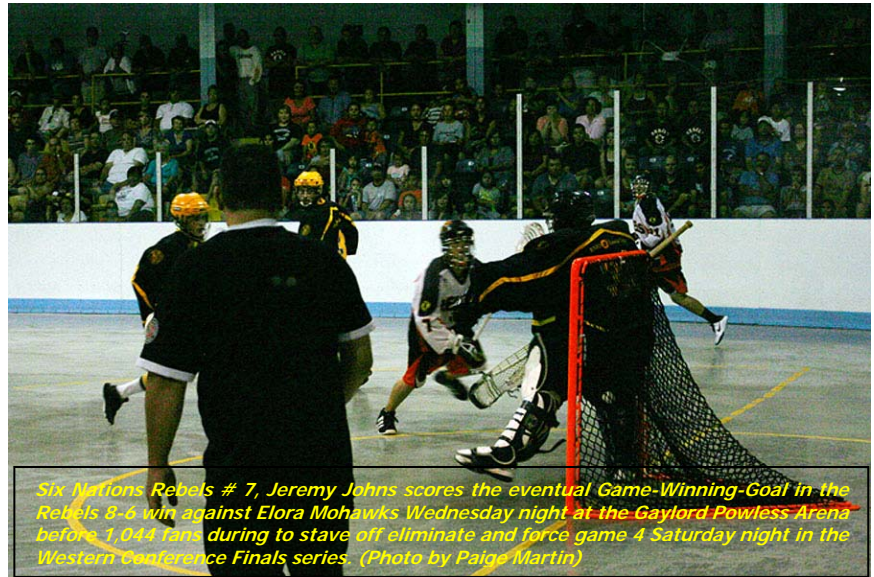
In the 2nd period, Rebels **Vaughn Harris** (2:26) and **J. Quinn Powless** at 3:08 later for a 3-2 Rebels lead. **Jeremy Johns** assisted the **Powless** goal to become the Rebels Franchise All-Time Post-season scoring leader with 141 (57G, 84A) points. **Kyle Goss** tied the game 54 seconds later. Rebels **Torrey VanEvery** notched his 1st goal of the series at 5:17 only to have Mohawks **Matt Hummel** tied the game at 6:42. **Wayne VanEvery** gave the Rebels the lead they would not relinquish at 8:35. **Chris Attwood** (10:17) and **Jeremy Johns** (2nd of the game and eventual Game-Winning-Goal) at 14:37 spelled the end of the evening for Mohawks goalie, **McGarr** as **Dan Humphrey** was his replacement the rest of the night. Rebels outshot the Mohawks 24-11 in the second frame.

In the third, **Wayne VanEvery** made it an 8-4 game at 4:20. Mohawks **Kyle Dobbie** (10:32) and **Jordan Godin** (12:55) cut the lead in half for an 8-6 final. Rebels outshot the Mohawks 24-12 in the third and 61-37 for the entire night. Rebels were led by **J. Quinn Powless** (1G, 4A) added 5-points. **Wayne VanEvery** (2G, 2A) and **Jeremy Johns** (2G, 2A) had four-point games apiece. **Torrey VanEvery** (1G, 2A) and **Jesse Johnson** (3A) had 3-points each. **Vaughn Harris** (1G, 1A) and **Chris Attwood** (1G, 1A) had two-point games. Single Rebels points were by **Rodd Squire** (1A).

Elora was lead by **Jake Weidner** (1G, 2A) added 3-points. **Dan Keane** (2A) had two-points. Single Mohawks points were by **Mark Pfohl** (1G), **Kyle Goss** (1G), **Matt Hummel** (1G), **Kyle Dobbie** (1G), **Jordan Godin** (1G), **Jordan Denny** (1A), **Shane MacDonald** (1A), **Brent Murphy** (1A), **Todd Scarrow** (1A), **Brady Heseltine** (1A) and goalie, **Ricky McGarr** (1A).

Game 4 of the series continues Saturday 7:00 PM at the Elora Community Centre. If necessary Game 5 is back at the Gaylord Powless Arena Sunday night for a 7:00 PM faceoff.

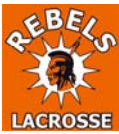

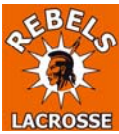
