## Six Nations Rebels drop heartbreaker to Elora Mohawks

**OHSWEKEN** – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels 2010 lacrosse season came to an end as Elora Mohawks won 10-9 Sunday night before 1,277 lacrosse fans at the Gaylord Powless Arena. The Rebels overcame an 8-3 deficit to grab to 9-8 third period lead. However a pair of goals by Elora Mohawks captain in the final 3 ½ minutes gave the Elora Mohawks and the Western Conference title. The Mohawks now face the Halton Hills Bulldogs in the OLA Jr B Finals.

This the 6<sup>th</sup> post-season meetings with Elora now holds a 4-2 edge in series wins.

The Rebels season comes to an end with 5 players graduating to Senior lacrosse in 2011. The 5 are **Korey Davis, Jason Johns, Jeremy Johns, Russell Longboat** and **Wayne VanEvery**. Three of the 5 set franchise records during their Jr B careers with the Rebels.

Rebels captain **Jason Johns** set record for playing the most post-season games (OLA Playoffs and Founders Cup) at 64 games. **Jeremy Johns** owns the record most post-season assists at 86. **Wayne VanEvery** set record of Most Combined goals with 176 in his 5-year career with the Rebels.

The Rebels started **Don Alton** in goal while the Mohawks started **Ricky McGarr** in goal.

The Mohawks **Jake Weidner** (5:12) and **Dan Keane** (6:28) made it 2-0 Elora. **Chris Attwood** got the Rebels on the scoreboard with a power play goal at 7:29. **Rodd Squire** tied the game at 11:59. The Mohawks **Kyle Dobbie** made it 3-2 with a power play marker with 25 second left on the scoreboard. Rebels outshot Elora 17-15 in the 1<sup>st</sup> period.

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> period, the Mohawks **Jordan Godin** (8:09) and captain **Brady Heseltine** (12:52) made it a 5-2 game. Rebels made a goalie change to put backup **Warren Hill** in goal. The Mohawks **Jordan Denny** made 6-2 at 14:34. Rebels put **Alton** back in goal only to have **Steve Hutchinson** make it 7-2 at 14:41. Rebels **Chris Attwood** (2<sup>nd</sup> goal of the game) cut the lead to 7-3 at 15:16 only to **Matt Hummel** score 22 seconds later for an 8-3 Elora lead. Rebels put **Hill** back in goal. Rebels **Rodd Squire** (2<sup>nd</sup> goal of the game) scored to make it an 8-4 score with 2:21 left in the second period. Rebels outshot the Mohawks 20-19 in the second frame.

In the third, Rebels mounted a comeback as **Jeremy Johns** (3:59), **J. Quinn Powless** (5:20), **Jeremy Johns** (5:48-2<sup>nd</sup> of the game) to make it an 8-7 game. Mohawks made a goalie change as **Dan Humphrey** when in the nets. **McGarr** returned to the nets at 6:02. However **Torrey VanEvery** complete the entire comeback at 6:39 to tie the game 8-8. **Vaughn Harris** gave the Rebels their 1<sup>st</sup> lead of the night at 9:28. **Humphrey** returned to the Mohawks net. Rebels did not test **Humphrey** much the rest of the contest. Mohawks **Heseltine** scored a power play goal with 3:34 remaining in regulation time to tie the game at 9-9. **Heseltine** would fire a 40-foot shot the found the mesh with 1:48 remaining. Rebels were unable to get the equalizer to end the Rebels season. Rebels outshot the Mohawks 17-10 in the third and 54-44 for the entire night.

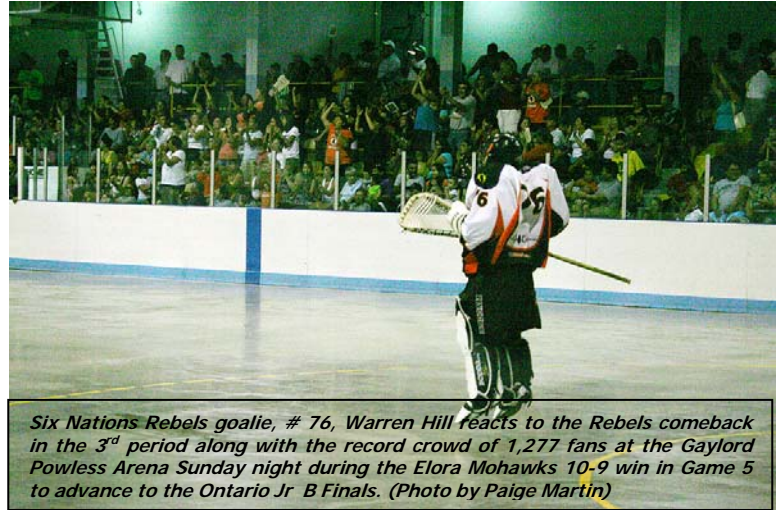
Rebels were led by **Chris Attwood** (2G, 3A) with a 5-point performance. **Torrey VanEvery** (1G, 3A) and **Wayne VanEvery** (4A) had 4-points each. **Jeremy Johns** (2G, 1A) added three-points. **Rodd Squire** (2G), **Jacob Bomberry** (2A) and **Jesse Johnson** (2A) had two-point games each. Single Rebels points were by **J. Quinn Powless** (1G), **Vaughn Harris** (1G) and **Johnson Jimerson** (1A).

Elora was lead by **Matt Hummel** (1G, 3A) and **Kyle Dobbie** (1G, 3A) with 4-points each. Captain **Brady Heseltine** (3G), **Jake Weidner** (1G, 2A) and **Dan Keane** (1G, 2A) added 3-points apiece. **Jordan Godin** (1G, 1A) and **Jordan Denny** (1G, 1A) had two-points. Single Mohawks points were by **Steve Hutchinson** (1G), **Alex Gleeson** (1A), **Kyle Goss** (1A), **Mark Pfohl** (1A), **Todd Scarrow** (1A) and **Brock Harper** (1A).

The Rebels-Elora series drew 3,097 for the 3 games at the Gaylord Powless Arena.
