Six Nations Rebels 12 Niagara Thunderhawks 5

OHSWEKEN – Just one day after the 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels spent fun a day with the Simcoe Minor Lacrosse Association at the Port Dover Arena to promote their upcoming season, the Rebels made it 2-for-2 in the young 2010 regular season when they defeated the Niagara Thunderhawks 12-5 Sunday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 612 lacrosse fans.

The Rebels did a little mix and mingle with the Simcoe minor children playing catch and taking shots on goalie, Quinton Martin (a Six Nations Midget goalie) and later played shorten exhibition game of lacrosse to the delight of the Simcoe Minor Lacrosse Association.

The Rebels also started the Rebels-Jukasa Studios Talent contest tonight with 3 powerful performances by the young ladies vying for the ultimate prize of a professionally recorded 3-Song Demo at Jukasa Studios. The 3 contestants are Crystal MacDonald, Avery Hill and Jaime Powless.

The Thunderhawks started Julian Fauzey in goal while the Rebels countered with Warren Hill between the pipes. This was the 19th meeting between the Rebels and Thunderhawks since 2003 with Six Nations now winning 16 of those matches.

The Rebels dominated the start of the contest by taking the first 10 shots on goal only to have the Thunderhawks' David Evert and Zach Antone score on their 1st two shots on the contest by the 5:57 mark. Antone would make it a 3-0 Niagara lead at 10:18 before the Rebels defensive squad got them back into the contest as James Mt. Pleasant, Stuart Martin (1st Jr B career goal) and Rodd Squire to even the contest at 3-3 after 20 minutes of play. The Rebels outshot the Thunderhawks 20 to 7 in the opening frame.

Rebels Rookie Alexander Martin notched his first career goal at 1:18. Just 17 seconds later, the Rebels offensive players finally got into the action as Vaughn Harris made it 5-3 Rebels only to have Zach Antone complete his hat-trick at 5:02 to make it a one-goal game. Harris restored the lead to 6-4 with a power play marker at 6:39. Assistant Captain, Jesse Johnson would score 22 seconds ahead of Harris and his hat-trick goal for an 8-4 Rebels lead. Niagara's Gaehnewrawene Printup added a power play goal at 13:11 only to have Rebels Danny Vyse beat Fauzey for a 9-5 lead after 40 minutes. Rebels outshot the Thunderhawks 21-9 in the middle stanza.

The third period was all Rebels with three unanswered goals as Jacob Bomberry and a pair by Wayne VanEvery rounded out the scoring on the night. Rebels outshot Niagara 11-6 in the third for a 52-22 edge in shots for the entire contest. The Rebels were led by Game MVP, Wayne VanEvery (2G, 2A) and rookie, Brandon Montour (4A) with 4-point performances each. Vaughn Harris (3G), Stuart Martin (1G, 2A) and J. Quinn Powless (3A) added three points each. James Mt. Pleasant (1G, 1A), Chris Attwood (2A), rookie Josh Johnson (2A) all finished with two-point games. Single Rebels points were by Rodd Squire (1G), Alexander Martin (1G), Jesse Johnson (1G), Danny Vyse (1G), Jacob Bomberry (1G) and goalie Warren Hill (1A).

The Rebels will embark on their first road game on Wednesday, April 28th when they travel to the Tony Rose Arena for a tilt with the Orangeville Jr B Northmen for an 8:00 PM start. Then return home for a Friday night tilt with the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 PM start.
