Six Nations Rebels 12 Oakville Buzz 10

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels faced their toughest test to date Sunday night as Torrey VanEvery snapped a 10-10 tie with 1:33 remaining to lift the Rebels to an entertaining 12-10 win over the Oakville Buzz Sunday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 590 on-the-edge-of-your-seat lacrosse fans. This was the 5th meeting between the Rebels and Buzz since 2002 with Six Nations winning all five regular season games. The Buzz started Tyler Sullivan in goal while the Rebels countered with Klayton Maracle between the pipes. The Buzz' Brad Galante opened the scoring at 0:22 into the contest. Rebels J. Quinn Powless would get that goal back less than two minutes later. The Buzz Dan Lomas would regain the lead just 11 seconds later. Again Rebels Jacob Bomberry responded with a marker at 4:25 to tie the score at 2-2. The Buzz's Lomas and Robert Bentivegna would finish off the scoring in the opening 20 minutes. The Buzz outshot the Rebels 17 to 13 in the opening 20-minutes. Rebels assistant captain, James Mt. Pleasant cut the lead to one at 3:25 to start a four goal run for the Rebels as Jeremy Johns, Vaughn Harris and Jacob Bomberry made it a 6-4 contest by the 6:35 mark of the 2nd period. This prompted Oakville Buzz to change goalies; out was Sullivan in was Graeme Kirkness. The move worked as the Buzz Ryan Adams would net a shorthanded marker at 7:12. The Buzz put Sullivan back in the net. Rebels would score three more in a row as Stuart Martin, Carney Johnson and Wayne VanEvery made it a 9-5 game by the 16:28. However, the Buzz would get goals from Bryan Cole and captain Braden Gallant for a 9-7 Rebels lead after 40 minutes.

The Rebels outshot the Buzz 24-15 shots each in the middle stanza.

In the third period the Buzz would tie the contest up as Gallant completed the hat-trick by 7:33. The Rebels Wayne VanEvery (2nd of the game) gave the Rebels a 10-9 lead at 10:13. Only to have the Buzz Kevin Harper score the tying goal with 3:40 remaining in the regulation time. Just when both teams were beginning to prepare for overtime, Rebels Torrey VanEvery bounced a shot past Buzz goalie Sullivan for the eventual game-winning-goal with 1:33 remaining on the clock. Rebels Chris Attwood put the on ice with 16 seconds left. Oakville outshot the Rebels 15-10 in the third as both teams finished with 47 shots each for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by J. Quinn Powless (1G, 5A) with a six-point night. OLA Jr B current scoring leader, Wayne VanEvery (2G, 2A) added four-points. Rebels Game MVP, Jacob Bomberry (2G, 1A) and Carney Johnson (1G, 2A) contributed three-points each. Jeremy Johns (1G, 1A), Torrey VanEvery (1G, 1A), Vaughn Harris (1G, 1A) and G. Dylan Johnson (2A) finished with two-points apiece. Single Rebels points were by James Mt. Pleasant (1G), Stuart Martin (1G), Chris Attwood (1G), Jacob Crans (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A), Tony Doxtator (1A), Alexander Martin (1A) and goalie Klayton Maracle (1A).

The Buzz were led by Dylan Gilbert (4A) with four helpers. Buzz Captain Braden Gallant (3G), Don Lomas (2G, 1A) and Patrick Corbett (3A) all contributed three-points each. Spencer Gallant and Tyler Sullivan added a pair of helpers apiece. Single Buzz points were by Brad Galante (1G), Robert Bentivegna (1G), Ryan Adams (1G), Bryan Cole (1G), Kevin Harper (1G) and goalie Graeme Kirkness (1A).

The Rebels travel to the Nichols Recreation Centre next game Saturday night at 7:00 PM to battle the London Blue Devils. The Buzz travel to Victoria Park Road Arena Thursday night for an 8:00 PM tilt with the Guelph Regals.
