Six Nations Rebels 15 Hamilton Bengals 4

OHSWEKEN - The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels kicked off the 2010 regular season with a 15-4 triumph over the visiting Hamilton Bengals Sunday night before 704 lacrosse fans at the Gaylord Powless Arena. Bengals started Six Nations resident, Jayson Gibson in goal while Klayton Maracle got the start for the Rebels. Six Nations got off to a quick 2-0 start Jesse Johnson and Torrey VanEvery just 2:49 into the contest. The Bengals captain, Brad Mazzocato cut the lead in half at 4:34 only to have the Rebels net four more in the next 10 minutes as Torrey VanEvery (2nd of the game), Chris Attwood, Jesse Johnson (2nd of the game) and Jake Bomberry would find the back of the net. Hamilton's Aaron Buswell and Rebels Chris Attwood would trade markers in the final two minutes for a 7-2 Rebels lead after 20 minutes of action.

The Rebels outshot the Bengals 22-11 in the first period.

The Bengals Darryl Waud and Zach Hill scored 26 seconds apart by the 1:35 mark of the middle frame to make it a 7-4 Rebels lead. That would be all the offense for Hamilton the rest of the night as Rebels goalie Maracle shut down the Bengals. Six Nations added goals by Chris Attwood (3rd of the game), Rodd Squire and Jesse Johnson (3rd of the game) ended the night for Bengals goalie Gibson at 7:34. Rebels Jeremy Johns would score the first goal against Gibson's replacement, John McNamara at 15:04 for an 11-4 Rebels after 40 minutes.

The Rebels outshot the Bengals 21-7 during the middle stanza.

The Rebels were on cruise control in the third as Chris Attwood (4th), Wayne VanEvery, Vaughn Harris and Attwood (5th) completed the scoring on the evening.

Rebels outshot the Bengals 14-8 in the third period and 57-26 for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by Game MVP, Chris Attwood with a 7-point (5G, 2A) performance. Jesse Johnson added 6-points (3G, 3A), Wayne VanEvery (1G, 4A) and J. Quinn Powless (5A) contributed 5-points each. Torrey VanEvery netted 4-points (2G, 2A). Jake Bomberry finished with three-points (1G, 2A). Jeremy Johns (1G, 1A) and goalie Klayton Maracle (2A) had a pair of points. Single Rebels points were by Rodd Squire (1G), Vaughn Harris (1G), Tony Doxtator (1A), Rhys Tansley (1A) and Carney Johnson (1A).

The Bengals were led by Game MVP, Darryl Waud and his two-point (1G, 1A) night. Single Bengals points were by Captain, Brad Mazzocato (1G), Aaron Buswell (1G), Zach Hill (1G), Scott MacFarlane (1A), Alexander Aquin (1A) and Ryan Ames (1A).

The Rebels will host to the Niagara Thunderhawks next Sunday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena for a 7:00 PM. Hamilton travels to the Glen Abbey Rec Centre Friday night for a tilt with the Oakville Buzz starting at 8:00 PM.
