Six Nations Rebels 15 St. Catharines Spartan Warriors 3

OHSWEKEN – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels made it 4-for-4 in the young 2010 regular season when they defeated the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors 15-3 Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 554 lacrosse fans. This was the 2nd game of four in five nights for the Rebels.

The Rebels also continued the Rebels-Jukasa Studios Talent contest tonight with 3 powerful performances by Jaime Powless, Avery Hill and Crystal MacDonald who are vying for the ultimate prize of a professionally recorded 3-Song Demo at Jukasa Studios.

The Spartan Warriors started Gavin Lecky in goal while the Rebels countered with Klayton Maracle between the pipes. This was the 34th regular season meeting between the Rebels and Spartan Warriors since 1997. Six Nations now holds a 17-16-1 edge in those matches.

The Rebels dominated the start of the contest by scoring 4 times (Jesse Johnson, Wayne VanEvery, Vaughn Harris and VanEvery again) on 6 shots to send starter Lecky to the bench in favour of backup Cam Fowler at 4:24 into the contest. VanEvery greeted Fowler by scoring his third of the game at 5:35 for 5-0 lead. The Spartan Warriors would get on the board with a power play marker by Kyle Winterbottom at 6:49. VanEvery scored his fourth of the game at 9:54 and Jacob Bomberry fired home his first of the night at 11:49 for a 7-1 lead. St. Catharines cut the lead to 7-2 as Dillon Hendsbee with a man advantage shot at 18:42. The Rebels outshot the Spartan Warriors 21-11 in the opening frame.

In the second period, it would be all Rebels as VanEvery potted his 5th of the night at 3:07. Vaughn Harris, Chris Attwood, Rodd Squire and Bomberry (2nd of the game) all found the back of the mesh for a 12-2 after 40 minutes of action. The Rebels outshot the Spartan Warriors 22-9 in the middle stanza.

The third period saw the Rebels on cruise control however; Tony Doxtator scored his first just 1:09 into the play. Jacob Bomberry completed his hat-trick at 5:04. The only thing that seemed to work for the Spartan Warriors was their power play as Kyle Rushton scored the third extra-man maker for the visitors at 11:21. Rebels Vaughn Harris completed his hat-trick at 12:37. Rebels were outshot by St. Catharines 17-13 in the third by finished with a 56-37 edge in shots for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by Wayne VanEvery (5G, 1A) and Jacob Bomberry (3G, 3A) with six-point nights each. Vaughn Harris (3G, 2A) and Chris Attwood (1G, 4A) added five-points. Jesse Johnson (1G, 3A) contributed with four-points each. Tony Doxtator (1G, 2A) with 3-points. Jeremy Johns (2A) and Quinn Powless (2A) added a pair of helpers each. Single Rebels points were by Rodd Squire (1G), Jacob Crans (1A), Stu Martin (1A), Brandon Montour (1A), Johnson Jimerson (1A) and Carney Johnson (1A).

The Spartan Warriors were led by Game MVP and Captain Drew Thomas with a pair of helpers. Single Spartan Warriors points were by Kyle Winterbottom (1G), Dillon Hendsbee (1G), Kyle Rushton (1G), Jake Ciaramella (1A), Matt Moore (1A) and T. J. Buck (1A).

The Rebels will hit the road game Saturday, May 1st when they travel to the Meridian Credit Union Arena for a tilt with the Niagara Thunderhawks and an 8:00 PM start. The Rebels then return home for a Sunday night match with the Oakville Buzz at the Gaylord Powless Arena for a 7:00 PM start.

St. Catharines host Elora Mohawks on Sunday at the Merritton Lions Arena for a 7:00 PM faceoff.
