Six Nations Rebels 9 Orangeville Northmen 5

ORANGEVILLE – The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels overcame a 5-3 third period deficit to defeat the Orangeville Northmen 9-5 Wednesday night at the Tony Rose Arena to start their first of four games in the next five nights on a winning note.

The Northmen started Curtis Rydall in goal while the Rebels countered with Don Alton between the pipes.

The Rebels Torrey VanEvery opened the scoring just 1:14 into the contest while the Northmen responded on goals by Andrew Stoner and Jayme Szabolcs (shorthanded) by the 13:49 mark. However the Rebels would retake the lead 3-2 after 20 minutes of play as J. Quinn Powless and Jake Bomberry managed to find the back of the net.

The Rebels outshot the Northmen 15 to 12 in the opening frame.

The second frame was all Northmen as Steve Rogers, Dustin Caravello (power play goal) and Travis Szabolcs scored on Rebels goalie Alton for a 5-3 Northmen lead after 40 minutes. Shots were even at 12-12 in the middle stanza.

The third period was all Rebels as they dominated the action by scoring six unanswered goals. Jesse Johnson got it started at 49 seconds into the third. Veteran Jeremy Johns tied the contest at 7:14 with Jake Bomberry netting the eventual game-winner with 6:56 on the clock. Jeremy Johns added his second of the game with a power play marker at 16:36. Vaughn Harris scored with 85 remaining and G. Dylan Johnson added an empty netter with 61 seconds left in the contest to seal the Rebels victory. Rebels outshot Orangeville 17-13 in the third for a 44-37 edge in shots for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by Game MVP, Jake Bomberry (2G, 1A), J. Quinn Powless (1G, 2A), Torrey VanEvery (1G, 2A) and Wayne VanEvery (3A) who contributed a 3-point performance. Jeremy Johns scored twice. Single Rebels points were by Jesse Johnson (1G), Vaughn Harris (1G), G. Dylan Johnson (1G), Rodd Squire (1A), Chris Attwood (1A), James Mt. Pleasant (1A) and goalie Don Alton (1A).

The Northmen were led by Dustin Caravello (1G, 1A), Andrew Stoner (1G, 1A) and Aaron McNutt (2A) with two-points each. Single Northmen points were by Jayme Szabolcs (1G), Steven Rogers (1G), Travis Szabolcs (1G), Cody McLeod (1A) and Nial Caravello (1A).

The Rebels will play their second of four games in five nights will be Friday night when they host the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 PM start.

The Northmen host Wallaceburg Red Devils Saturday night at the Tony Rose Arena with a 7:00 PM start.
