**Six Nations Rebels 20 Wallaceburg Red Devils 10 WALLACEBURG** - The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels made it 3-and-0 to start the 2011 regular season following a fight-filled 20-10 win over the Wallaceburg Red Devils Saturday night before 450 lacrosse fans at the Wallaceburg Memorial Arena. A total of 208 minutes in penalties were distributed to both squads.

The Rebels extended their current regular season winning streak to 26-games. The winning streak dates back to a 6-6 overtime tie with the Windsor Clippers on June 12, 2009. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was a 7-6 loss to the Owen Sound NorthStars on June 7, 2009.

Rebels gave rookie goalie, Quintan Martin his first taste of Jr B action while the Red Devils started, Kirby Celotto.

Six Nations jumped out to a quick 2-0 lead 52 seconds into the contest on goals by Jacob Bomberry and Danny Vyse. However, the Red Devils soon countered with quick goals of their own by the 5:22 mark as Reid Miller (shorthanded), Jordan Durston and Jordan Vandamme gave the home squad a 3-2 lead. Rebels opted for a goalie change as H. Warren Hill took over the Rebels goaltending duties. Rebels Chris Attwood netted a pair (first goal on power play) and Vyse potted his second of the game for a Rebels 5-3 lead. Rebels Jesse Johnson was called for holding as Dillon Lapointe was on a breakaway at 12:03. Lapointe was awarded a penalty shot. Lapointe converted the opportunity to make it 5-4. Rebels Jacob Bomberry scored at 14:45. Randy Martin scored with a man-advantage for a 7-4 Rebels at 15:42. Wallaceburg changed their goaltenders to Haven Moses at this time. Red Devils Reid Miller replied with his second shorthanded goal of the period at 19:13 to a make it 7-5 after 20 minutes of action.

The Rebels outshot the Red Devils 20-14 in the first period.

The Rebels Randy Martin opened the 2<sup>nd</sup> period with his second of the game at 3:46. Carney Johnson made it 9-5 just 19 seconds later. Wallaceburg's Clint Lamarsh scored a power play goal 1:40 later. Rebels Jacob Bomberry completed his hat-trick just past the midway point of the game. Red Devils Rob Pollock answered with a power play goal with less than two minutes on the clock. Rebels Carney Johnson netted his second of the game just 24 seconds later for an 11-7 lead after 40 minutes of play.

Both teams had 17 shots apiece in the second frame.

The final period saw plenty of scoring as the Rebels would outscore the Red Devils 9-3. The Rebels scored five times in the first 4:51 as Jesse Johnson, Jacob Bomberry (4<sup>th</sup>), Vaughn Harris, Jacob Bomberry (5<sup>th</sup>) and Chris Attwood (3<sup>rd</sup>) to chase Red Devils goalie Moses to the showers while Celotto returned to finish the contest. Rebels started Quintan Martin returned to the contest at 3:03 of the third. Harris potted his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the game at 6:22. Rebels Rookie Joe Haodias Maracle scored his 1<sup>st</sup> career Jr B goal at 7:37 while killing a penalty. Wallaceburg's Reid Miller would score all three third period goals; two of Miller's goals were on the power play. Rebels Tony Doxtator (power play) and Maracle (2<sup>nd</sup> of the game) finished off the game scoring.

Rebels outshot Wallaceburg 18-11 in the third to finish with a 55-42 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by game MVP Chris Attwood (3G, 3A), Jacob Bomberry (5G, 1A) and Randy Martin (2G, 4A) with six point each. Vaughn Harris (2G, 2A), Danny Vyse (2G, 2A), Carney Johnson (2G, 2A) and Dallas John (4A) all finished with 4-points each. Jesse Johnson (1G, 2A), Tony Doxtator (1G, 2A) and Brandon Montour (3A) added three points apiece. Joe Haodias Maracle scored twice while single Rebels points were by Jesse Jimerson (1A), Spencer Hill (1A), Rhys Tansley (1A) and H. Warren Hill (1A).

The Red Devils were led by game MVP Reid Miller (5G) and Clint Lamarsh (1G, 4A) with five-points each. Dillon Lapointe (1G, 3A) added four-points. Rob Pollock (1G, 2A) contributed three-points. Jordan Durston (1G, 1A), Brendan Shepley (2A) and Joel Shepley (2A) added two-point games. Single Wallaceburg points were by Jordan Vandamme (1G) and Drake Brown (1A).

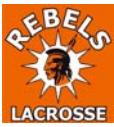

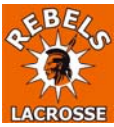

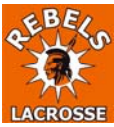
