Six Nations Rebels 13 St. Catharines Spartans 7

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time Founders Cup champions and 2012 Founders Cup host, Six Nations Rebels improved to 7-and-0 following a 13-7 triumph over South West Division rival, St. Catharines Spartans Friday night at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena before 550 lacrosse fans.

The Rebels extended their current regular season winning streak to 30-games. The winning streak dates back to a 6-6 overtime tie with the Windsor Clippers on June 12, 2009. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was a 7-6 loss to the Owen Sound NorthStars on June 7, 2009.

The Spartans started former Jr A goalie, Nate Barlow in goal while the Rebels countered with rookie netminder Quintan Martin.

The Spartans jumped out to a quick 2-0 lead on goals by Kyle Potter and Jim Sheehan by the 3:56 mark. It took the Rebels almost to mid-point of the first period before finally scoring as Chris Attwood finished off a breakaway at 9:38. Jacob Bomberry even the count at 12:04. Rebels rookie Joe Haodias

Maracle put the Rebels ahead for good with 2:31 remaining in the first period. Just 38 seconds later, Vaughn Harris gave the Rebels a two-goal lead after 20 minutes of action. The Rebels outshot the Spartans 15-8 in the first period.

The middle period saw the Rebels outscore the Spartans 5-3 as Tony Doxtator, Brandon Montour, Harris (2nd of the game), Maracle (2nd of the game) with eventual Game-Winning-Goal and J. Quinn Powless found their mark while captain Dillon Hendsbee, Braden Handley and Kyle Parsons respond for St. Catharines in the middle stanza. Rebels outshot the Spartans 16-15 in the second period.

The Rebels would outscore the Spartans 4-2 in the third for the win. Vaughn Harris completed his hat-trick, J. Quinn Powless (2nd of the night), Jacob Bomberry (2nd of the night) and Brandon Montour (2nd of the night) scored for the Rebels in the third period. Kyle Potter (2nd of the night) and Tyler Strassburg retorted for St. Catharines. Rebels outshot St. Catharines 15-8 in the third to finish with a 46-31 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by game MVP J. Quinn Powless (2G, 4A) and Brandon Montour (2G, 4A) with 6-point efforts. Vaughn Harris (3G, 2A) and Jacob Bomberry (2G, 3A) added 5-points each. Joe Haodias Maracle (2G, 2A) had a four-point night. Chris Attwood (1G, 1A), Tony Doxtator (1G, 1A), Danny Vyse (2A), Dallas John (2A) and goalie Quintan Martin (2A) all had two-points games. The Spartans were led by Kyle Potter (2G, 3A) with a five-point evening. Game MVP Jim Sheehan (1G, 3A) contributed four-points. Kyle Parsons (1G, 1A), Braden Handley (1G, 1A) and Tyler Strassburg (1G, 1A) finished with two-points each. Single Spartans points were by Dillon Hendsbee (1G) and Craig Attwood (1A).

The Rebels host to the Mid West Division leading Orangeville Northmen Sunday night at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena with a 7:00 PM start.

The Spartans hosts the Owen Sound NorthStars Saturday night at the Merritton Lions Arena for a 7:00 pm faceoff.

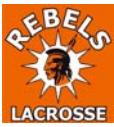

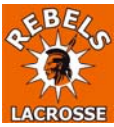
