## Six Nations Rebels 12 St. Catharines Spartans 9

**ST. CATHARINES** - The 3-time Founders Cup champions and 2012 Founders Cup hosts' Six Nations Rebels had their first true test Sunday night at the Merritton Lions Arena to come-from-behind to win their 14<sup>th</sup> of the season with a 12-9 win over St. Catharines Spartans before 200 fans.

The Rebels extended their current regular season winning streak to 37-games. The winning streak dates back to a 6-6 overtime tie with the Windsor Clippers on June 12, 2009. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was a 7-6 loss to the Owen Sound NorthStars on June 7, 2009.

The Spartans started, **Nate Barlow** in goal while the Rebels countered with **Don Alton**.

The Spartans jumped out to a 2-0 lead on goals by **Tyler Strassburg** (power play goal at 4:33) and **Kyle Winterbottom** at 11:09. Rebels responded by scoring the next four markers with a pair by **Chris Attwood** at 13:20 and 14:39 (power play), **Brodie Tansley** (16:46) and **Attwood** to completed the 1<sup>st</sup> period hat-trick with a shorthanded goal at 17:54. The Spartans outshot the Rebels 19-13 in the first period.

St. Catharines **Charlie Sheehan** made it 4-3 just 48 from the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> period. Spartans leading-scorer, Kyle Potter would net a pair just 70 seconds apart for a 5-4 home town lead. Rebels coaching staff were forced to take a timeout at this point of the contest to settle the troops. Rebels' defensive specialist, Rhys Tansley tied the score at 9:01. **Vaughn Harris** gave Six Nations the lead just 12 seconds later and acting captain **Jesse Johnson** made it 7-5 less than a minute later. Spartans captain Dillon Hendsbee made it a one-goal game at 12:33. **Charlie Sheehan** (2<sup>nd</sup> of the game) tied the contest at 15:17 while **Jim Sheehan** made it 8-7 with a power play effort at 16:14. Rebels **Rhys Tansley** (2<sup>nd</sup> of the period) would tie the game again at 17:53 only to have **Charlie Sheehan** complete his 1<sup>st</sup> career hat-trick at 18:13 for a 9-8 St. Catharines lead after 40 minutes of play. The Spartans outshot the Rebels 21-12 in the second period.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> period saw the Rebels take control as goalie **Alton** would shutout the Spartans in the final 20 minutes while **Attwood** (4<sup>th</sup> of the game) at 2:54 to tie the score. The Rebels eventual Game-Winning-Goal was scored by **Ian Martin** at 5:02 while **Tyler Leblanc** made it 11-9 at 6:09. Rebels **Brandon Montour** assist of the **Leblanc** power play goal broke the franchise mark of most assists in a single season. It was **Montour's** 66<sup>th</sup> of the season breaking the previous record of 65 by **Ben Powless** in 2003. Rebels rookie **Marcus Elvin** finish all scoring off with an empty net goal at 19:06. Rebels outshot St. Catharines 14-8 in the third, however the Spartans finished with a 50-39 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by **Chris Attwood** (4G) and **Brandon Montour** (4A) with four-point performances. **Tyler Leblanc** (1G, 2A) finished with three points. **Rhys Tansley** (2G), **Vaughn Harris** (1G, 1A), **Jesse Johnson** (1G, 1A), **Ian Martin** (1G, 1A), **Carney Johnson** (2A), **Spencer Hill** (2A) and goalie **Don Alton** (2A) all had 2-point evenings. Single Rebels points were by **Brodie Tansley** (1G), **Marcus Elvin** (1G), **Luc Chatelain** (1A), **Dallas John** (1A) and Rebels Game MVP **Jacob Crans** (1A).

The Spartans were led by game MVP **Charlie Sheehan** (3G, 1A), **Kyle Potter** (2G, 2A) and **Jim Sheehan** (1G, 3A) with 4-point efforts. **Tyler Strassburg** (1G, 2A) with 3-points. Captain **Dillon Hendsbee** (1G, 1A), **Brady Lawrence** (2A) and **Marcus Butters** (2A) added a pair of points. Single Spartans points were by **Kyle Winterbottom** (1G), **Braden Handley** (1A), **Sean Richardson** (1A) and goalie **Nate Barlow** (1A).

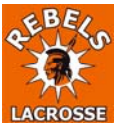

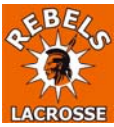

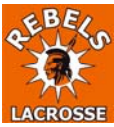
