## Hamilton Bengals 10 Six Nations Rebels 8

**HAMILTON** - The 3-time Founders Cup champions and 2012 Founders Cup hosts' Six Nations Rebels 39-game winning streak came to end on an emotion day for the Six Nations Rebels squad. Hamilton Bengals won 10-8 Thursday night at the Dave Andreychuk Arena.

Earlier in the day, the Rebels said goodbye to former Rebels player and 2010 Assistant Coach Keegan Gregory Hill who past away as a result of automobile accident on Sunday. The winning streak had dated back to a 6-6 overtime tie with the Hamilton Bengals on June 12, 2009. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was a 7-6 loss to the Owen Sound NorthStars on June 7, 2009.

The Bengals started, **Brett Perras** in goal while the Rebels countered with rookie, **Quintan Martin**.

The Bengals **Shane Simpson** scored the only goal in the first period at 12:20. The Rebels outshot the Bengals 22-12 in the first period.

The Rebels looked like they had control of the contest in the 2<sup>nd</sup> period as **Ian Martin** scored twice (9:49 and 11:51) as did **Tony Doxtator** only 24 seconds apart starting at 12:14. **Martin** completed his hat-trick at 13:18 for a 5-1 Rebels lead. Bengals' **Tristan Schram** got the comeback started with a shorthanded goal at 14:44. A little over two and a half minutes later, **Spencer Ridgewell** cut the lead down to two. Then **Derek Searle** made it a one-goal game at 18:24. The Rebels outshot the Bengals 18-14 in the second period.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> period the Bengals Jr C call-up, Paul Daniel score his 1<sup>st</sup> Jr B goal at 5:01 to tie the game 5-5. **Simpson** gave the Bengals a lead they would not relinquish with a power play marker at 6:44. The home team got a couple of more goals from **Daniel Williams** (9:22) and **Tristan Schram** (9:46) for an 8-5 lead. Rebels **Jacob Crans** cut the lead down to 8-6 at 12:16. Bengals **Schram** would net the eventual game-winner at 1:30 later. Rebels **Jacob Bomberry** scored a shorthanded goal at 14:12 only to have Bengals **Mitch Iszkula** restore the 3-goal lead one minute later. Rebels pressed on despite being shorthanded as **Chris Attwood** scored at 16:15 to finish off the scoring on the night. Rebels outshot Hamilton 13-10 in the third to finish with a 53-36 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by game MVP **Ian Martin** (3G, 1A) and **Jacob Bomberry** (1G, 3A) with 4-point performances. **Tony Doxtator** (2G, 1A), **Chris Attwood** (1G, 2A) and **Brandon Montour** (3A) all had three-point evenings. Captain **Alex Martin** (2A) finished with 2 points. Single Rebels points were by **Jacob Crans** (1G), **Dallas John** (1A), **Carney Johnson** (1A), **James Garlow** (1A) and **Marcus Elvin** (1A).

The Bengals were led by **Tristan Schram** (3G, 1A) with 4-points. **Shane Simpson** (2G, 1A) added a 3-point effort. **Mitch Iszkula** (1G, 1A), **Mitch Bolduc** (2A) and Bengals game MVP goalie, **Brett Perras** (2A). Single Bengals points were by **Spencer Ridgewell** (1G), **Derek Searle** (1G), **Paul Daniel** (1G), **Daniel Williams** (1G), **Matt McCallum** (1A) and **George Magur** (1A).

The Rebels host St. Catharines Spartans Friday night for an 8:00 PM face at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena.

The Bengals complete their 2011 season when they play at the Merritton Lions Arena Sunday night versus St. Catharines Spartans at 7:00 pm faceoff.

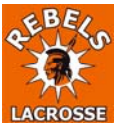

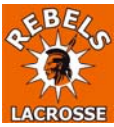
