Rebels take series open 21-9 over Windsor

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time Founders Cup champions and 2012 Founders Cup hosts' Six Nations Rebels grabbed a 1-0 series lead with a 21-9 win over Windsor Clippers in the Best-of-Five Western Conference Semi-Final series Friday night before 572 spectators at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena.

The Clippers started **Brandon Stevenson** in goal while the Rebels started, **Don Alton**.

The Clippers grabbed a 2-0 lead in the first 93 seconds on goals by **Trevor Learn** (1:16) and **Graham Adams** (1:33). Rebels responded with 3 straight of the own by **Tony Doxtator** (2:15), **Vaughn Harris** (5:18) and **Jesse Johnson** (7:03). The Clippers **Corey Burchell** (14:48) tied the game only to have Rebels **Jacob Bomberry** (16:01) restore a brief lead. Clippers **Steve Hinek** would tie the game 4-4 just 50 seconds later. Rebels outshot the Clippers 15-13 in the first period.

The Rebels would outscore the Clippers 11-2 in the middle frame. The Rebels **Tyler Leblanc** got things started 0:52 into the action. **Chris Attwood** (3:01) and **Bomberry** (2nd of the game at 3:46) forced the Clippers coaches to make a goalie change as backup goalie **Kyle May** took over the duties. However, **Jacob Crans** made it an 8-4 just 77 seconds later. Clippers **Brendon Anger** (6:39) got one back on the power play. Rebels **Dallas John** (8:45) scored just seconds after serving a penalty. **Harris** (2nd of the game at 11:57) and **Attwood** (13:42) made it 11-5. Clippers **Hinek** (2nd of the game at 14:38) made it 11-6. Rebels got goals from **Brandon Montour** (15:02), **Harris** (hat-trick at 16:29), **Montour** (2nd of the game at 17:17) and **Bomberry** (hat-trick at 18:15) to finish with a 15-6 lead after 40 minutes of play. Rebels outshot the Clippers 23-10 in the second period.

The third period saw the Rebels score twice and the Clippers respond with a power play on three separate occasions. Rebels **John** (2nd of the game at 3:45) and **Harris** (4th of the game at 10:17) while Clippers **Alex Seguin** (power play goal at 12:31). Rebels **J. Quinn Powless** (12:40) and **Montour** (hat-trick at 12:56) netted shorthanded goals each. Windsor captain **Jeff Rivait** (15:57) connected with a power play goal. Rebels **Doxtator** (2nd of the game at 17:17) and **Bomberry** (4th of the game at 19:18) while **Seguin** finished the game with a power play with just 16 seconds remaining on the clock. Rebels outshot the Clippers 16-13 in the third period, however the Rebels finished with a 54-36 edge for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by **Chris Attwood** (2G, 6A) with an 8-point game. **Brandon Montour** (3G, 4A) dished out 7-points. **Jacob Bomberry** (4G, 2A) contributed a 6-point night. **Vaughn Harris** (4G, 1A), **Tyler Leblanc** (1G, 4A) and **J. Quinn Powless** (1G, 4A) all had 5-point nights. **Tony Doxtator** (2G, 1A) and **Jesse Johnson** (1G, 2A) had 3-point games. **Dallas John** (2G), **Jacob Crans** (1G, 1A), captain **Alex Martin** (2A) and goalie **Don Alton** added 2-points apiece. Single Rebels points were by **Lucas Smith** (1A), **Carney Johnson** (1A), **Danny Vyse** (1A) and **Luc Chatelain** (1A).

The Clippers were lead by **Alex Seguin** (2G, 3A) and captain **Jeff Rivait** (1G, 4A) with 5-points each. **Steve Hinek** (2G, 2A) had a 4-point night. **Trevor Learn** (1G, 2A) added 3-points. **Graham Adams** (1G, 1A) and **Brendon Anger** (1G, 1A) 2-points each. Single Clippers points were by **Corey Burchell** (1G), **Steve Weingarden** (1A) and **John Nowicki** (1A).

Game two of the series is Tuesday, July 12th at the Forest Glade Arena for an 8:00 P.M. start. (Best-of-Five) Six Nations leads series 1-0.

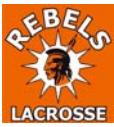

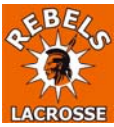
