Rebels sweep Windsor; Elora is next

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time Founders Cup champions and 2012 Founders Cup hosts' Six Nations Rebels completed the sweep of the Windsor Clippers Saturday night with a 17-5 at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena (ILA) to win the Best-of-Five Western Conference Semi-Finals series 3-0 before 530 spectators. The will face Elora Mohawks in the Western Conference Finals for the 4th consecutive year. The series opener will begin on 8:00 P. M. on Friday, July 22nd at the ILA.

The Clippers started **Kyle May** in goal while the Rebels started, **Brennor Jacobs**.

The Rebels grabbed a 6-1 lead on goals by **Tony Doxtator** (7:04), **Chris Attwood** (7:30), **Vaughn Harris** (10:12), **Danny Vyse** (13:22), **Brandon Montour** (14:14) and **Jacob Bomberry** with eventual Game-Winning-Goal at 17:55. The Clippers lone 1st period marker was by their regular season leading scorer, **Brett Hickey** (shorthanded at 9:54). The Clippers outshot the Rebels 16-15 in the first period.

The Rebels would push the score to 10-1 on goals by **Harris** (2nd of the game at 1:02), **J. Quinn Powless** (1:29), **Vyse** (2nd of the game, shorthanded @ 3:47) and **Montour** (2nd of the game at 6:42). The Clippers got a couple of power play goals by **Steve Hinek** (8:52) and **Brendon Anger** (9:38) to make it 10-3. Rebels **Tyler Leblanc** (10:06) and Clippers **Adam Moore** (16:38) traded goals in the second of the middle period for an 11-4 Rebels lead after 40 minutes of action. The Rebels outshot the Clippers 22-16 in the second period.

The third period saw the Rebels **Attwood** (2nd of the game at 3:36), **Montour** (hat-trick at 7:49), **Doxtator** (2nd of the game at 9:15) and **Jacob Crans** (9:59) make it 15-4 before the Clippers **Cameron Rogers** (14:41) scored their final goal for 2011. The Rebels **Powless** (2nd of the game at 15:01) and **Attwood** (hat-trick at 17:05) completed the scoring on the series. Rebels outshot the Clippers 18-13 in the third period to finish with a 55-45 edge in shots for the entire contest.

The Rebels were led by **Brandon Montour** (3G, 5A) with an 8-point performance. **Chris Attwood** (3G, 3A) with a 6-point game. **Jacob Bomberry** (1G, 4A) added 5-points. **Tony Doxtator** (2G, 2A), **J. Quinn Powless** (2G, 2A) and **Tyler Leblanc** (1G, 3A) contributed 4-point efforts. **Vaughn Harris** (2G, 1A) and **Carney Johnson** (3A) added three points. **Danny Vyse** (2G), **Jacob Crans** (1G, 1A) and goalie **Brennor Jacobs** (2A) had a pair of points. Single Rebels points were by captain **Alex Martin** (1A), **Ian Martin** (1A) and **Jesse Jimerson** (1A).

The Clippers were led by **Steve Hinek** (1G, 2A) and **Cameron Rogers** (1G, 2A) finished with 3-point nights. **Brett Hickey** (1G, 1A) and **Trevor Learn** (2A) had a pair of points. Single Clippers points were by **Adam Moore** (1G), **John Nowicki** (1A), captain **Jeff Rivait** (1A) and goalie **Kyle May** (1A).

The Rebels now face Elora Mohawks in the Western Conference Finals while the Clarington Green Gaels face defending Founders Cup champion, Halton Hills Bulldogs in the Eastern Conference Finals.

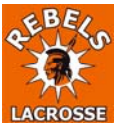

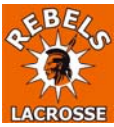
