Rebels kick 2011 with Annual Inter-Squad Game

SIX NATIONS - The 3-Time Founders Cup Champion, Six Nations Rebels will kick off their 2011 lacrosse season with their annual Inter-Squad Game this Sunday, March 20th at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena (ILA) with a start time of 8:00 PM. The Inter-Squad Game has become an annual event for the organization with many of the 2011 hopeful donning Rebels attire in one of their last bids to attract the attention from the Rebels coaching staff. There will be a \$ 2.00 admission charge for the Inter-Squad Game or a non-perishable food item with all the proceeds going to the Six Nations Food Bank.

The Rebels coaching staff will give the players a final chance to impress the following Saturday, March 26th during the 4th Annual Jr B Spring Showcase at the ILA when seven (7) other teams will join the Rebels to play 12 games in that day to start the Jr B 2011 pre-season activities. Hamilton Bengals, Halton Hills Bulldogs, Kahnawake Hunters, Mississauga Tomahawks, Newmarket Saints, Oakville Buzz and Windsor Clippers will make the trek to Six Nations for the one-day event.

The Rebels will play in the Western Conference of the 26-team OLA Jr B league. The Rebels will play their South West Division rivals, Hamilton Bengals, Niagara Thunderhawks, St. Catharines Spartans and the Welland Warlords three times each this year. The Rebels will face other Western Conference teams once each. They are Elora Mohawks, Guelph Regals, London Blue Devils, Orangeville Northmen, Owen Sound NorthStars, Sarnia Pacers, Wallaceburg Red Devils and Windsor Clippers. Oakville Buzz has moved back to the Eastern Conference with the Toronto Jr B Beaches taking a 1-year hiatus.

The Rebels will play all home games at the ILA as the executive noted there was a need to accommodate for the growing crowds which attend the Rebels games in comfort and safety. The Gaylord Powless Arena (GPA) is a terrific lacrosse facility, unfortunately during the 2010 playoff run the Rebels crowds were over flowing which forced some fans to sit on the steps of aisles during the games. During the Conference Finals against the Elora Mohawks, the Rebels drew 3,047 fans to the 3 home games of the series which capped off with 1,227 attending game 5 of the series.

The GPA has limited seating capacity of fewer than 1,000 while the ILA has seating capacity of over 3,000. The ILA floor size has been made special for all the young athletes who aspirations of playing in the National Lacrosse League. The floor is 200 feet in length by 85 feet in width which is the same as the Air Canada Center. The seamless glass makes for the better viewing pleasure for the fans. The air-conditioned ILA also has additional amenities such as a banquet hall, Bow Hunter Variety and the Powless Lacrosse Store for the lacrosse fans to check out during pre-game and intermissions.

Come out to support the 2011 Rebels at the beautiful ILA. The Rebels regular season runs from mid-April to late June followed by OLA Jr B Playoffs with the ultimate goal of playing for the 2011 Founders Cup in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan from August 14th to 21st.

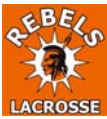

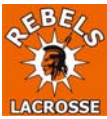
