PRESS RELEASE – 2011 # 7

SIX NATIONS – The 3-Time Founders Cup champion, Six Nations Rebels have begun to put the piece together for the 2011 Jr B lacrosse season. The Rebels announce 13 players have signed to be Six Nations Rebels as they take aim at the 2011 Founders Cup championships which will be played in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan in August later this year.

The Rebels begin with two quality netminders in Don Alton and H. Warren Hill.

The Rebels have high scoring, Chris Attwood returning along with Vaughn Harris and rookie Dallas John on the right-side while the left side features 2010 OLA Jr B Rookie-of-the-Year, Jacob Bomberry. Joining Bomberry on the left side will be Jesse Johnson, Josh Johnson and Tony Doxtator.

Rebels also inked Carney Johnson and rookie, Spencer Hill will lead the transition attack.

Defensively, the Rebels will have the leadership of Alex Martin along with defenseman, Rhys Tansley.

The Rebels will begin their 2011 season opener Sunday, April 17th when they host the Welland Warlords at the new home of the Rebels, the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena with 7 PM opening faceoff.



Don Alton, 18 year-old netminder returns for his 3rd season with the Rebels. Alton was a member of the 2008 Founders Cup team as a Midget call-up. Alton had a breakout year in 2010 by going 7-and-0 in 7 regular season starts with a 5.72 goals-against-average (GAA) and a .851 save percentage (Sv%). Alton added a pair of assists during the regular season.

Alton posted a 7-and-1 playoff record last year with a 5.51 GAA and a .861 Sv%. Alton added three assists during the playoff run of 2010.



Chris Attwood, 19 year-old high-scoring play maker had a career best in 2010 with the Rebels finishing with 87 regular season (31G, 56A) points in 19 games. Attwood had a team-leading 16 power play goals. Attwood added 33 playoff (14G, 19A) points in 11 games in 2010. Attwood's offensive gifts has enable him to accumulate 263 combined career (112 G, 151A) points since 2007 when he began his career with the St. Catharines Spartans. Attwood was acquired by the Rebels in April 2010 from St. Catharines.



Jacob Bomberry, 16 year-old talented OLA 2010 Rookie-of-the-Year enters his 3rd season with the Rebels. Bomberry amassed 83 regular season (33G, 50A) points. Bomberry lead the Rebels with 26 power play assists. Bomberry added 25 Playoff (13G, 12A) points in 2010. Bomberry won the Rebels Rookie-of-the-Year and Most Sportsmanlike Player for his four minor penalties. Bomberry has already amassed 120 combined career (49G, 71A) points with the Rebels.

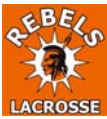

Tony Doxtator, 19 year-old veteran enters his 2nd season with the Rebels. Doxtator was acquired from the London Blue Devils at the start of the 2010 season. Doxtator will be called upon to contribute to the Rebels offensive left sided after adding 13 regular season (3G, 10A) points in 8 regular season games.



Vaughn Harris, 18 year-old offensively skilled faceoff man, enters his 3rd year with Rebels after having a breakout year in 2010 when he amassed 68 regular season (39G, 29A) points including a league-leading 5 shorthanded goals. Harris contributed 22 playoff (9G, 13A) points in 2010. Harris has scored 125 combined career (62G, 53A) points to date.



Spencer Hill, turned 17 years-old on April 4th, a transition specialist is entering his rookie season with the Rebels after helping the Six Nations Midgets win the Ontario "A" Champions and the Iroquois Nationals Midgets win the Gold Medal in 2010.



H. Warren Hill, 18 year-old enters his third year as a Rebels netminder. Hill won all 8 regular season starts in 2010 while adding 8 assists to go with his 4.89 GAA and .859 Sv%. Hill had a 1-and-2 playoff record in 2010 with a 5.89 GAA and .857 Sv%. Entering 2010, Hill has career combined record of 16-7-0 and a career 5.47 GAA and .846 Sv% with 14 career assists.



Dallas John, 16 year-old offensive rookie will turn 17 on April 21st. John is expected add to the offense as he contributed to the he Six Nations Midgets win the Ontario "A" Champions and the Iroquois Nationals Midgets win the Gold Medal in 2010.

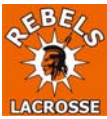

Carney Johnson, 18 years-old transition player with some offensive talent to with his toughness. Johnson enters his 3rd season with the Rebels. Johnson led the Rebels with 90 penalty minutes in 2010. Johnson contributed 19 regular season (6G, 13A) points in 2010. Johnson has a career combined record of 32 combined (9G, 23A) points with 131 penalty minutes.



Jesse Johnson, 18 years-old enters his 4th year with the Rebels. Johnson had 36 regular season (12G, 24A) points and 17 post-season (4G, 13A) points in 2010. Johnson has accumulated 109 career combined (29G, 80A) points since 2008. Johnson was also a member of the 2008 Founders Cup team.



Josh Johnson, 16 years-old enters his 2nd season with the Rebels, but still qualifies as a rookie after having played only 3 games in 2010 when he scored once and added 5 assists. Johnson scored his 1st Jr B career goal just 50 seconds into the contest against Wallaceburg Red Devils goalie, Kirby Celotto to help the Rebels to a 16-4 back on May 9, 2010 at the Gaylord Powless Arena.



Alex Martin, 17 years-old defenseman enters his sophomore season with the Rebels after an impressive rookie season. Martin finished with 5 regular season (1G, 4A) points in 2010. Martin scored his 1st career Jr B goal against Niagara Thunderhawks goalie Julian Fauzey at 1:18 of the second period to help the Rebels to a 12-5 win on April 25, 2010 at the Gaylord Powless Arena.



Rhys Tansley, 19 years-old defenseman also enters his 2nd year with the Rebels. Tansley was claimed from the Player Pool in 2010 after spending 2009 with the Hamilton Bengals. Tansley played 10 regular season with Rebels recording an assists. Tansley contributed a pair of helpers in the 2010 playoffs. Tansley has 1 career Jr B goal when he scored an unassisted first period marker against Wallaceburg Red Devils goalie, Matt Glover at 7:08 during a 14-13 while with the Hamilton Bengals on June 19, 2009.
