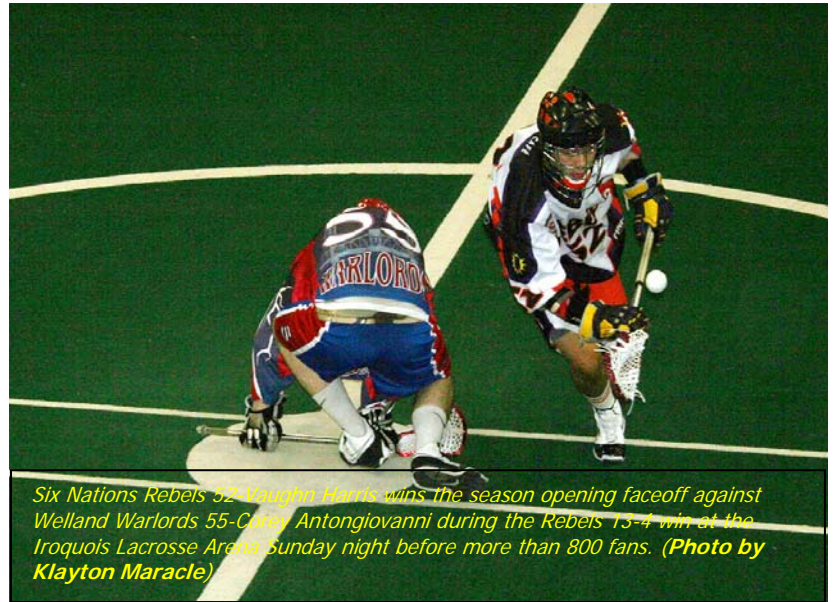

Six Nations Rebels 13 Welland Warlords 4

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time Founders Cup champions, Six Nations Rebels opened the 2011 regular season with a dominating 13-4 win over the South West Division rivals' Welland Warlords Sunday night before more than 800 lacrosse fans at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena. The Rebels extended their current regular season winning streak to 24-games. The winning streak dates back to a 6-6 overtime tie with the Windsor Clippers on June 12, 2009. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was a 7-6 loss to the Owen Sound NorthStars on June 7, 2009. Warlords started Brennor Jacobs in goal while H. Warren Hill got the start in goal for the Rebels.

Six Nations Tony Doxtator opened the scoring 3:44 into the contest. Welland's Corey Antongiovanni evened the score at 10:03. Randy Martin gave the home squad a lead they would not give up 65 seconds later.

The Rebels outshot the Warlords 26-9 in the first period.

The second period was all Rebels as Brandon Montour scored on a deflected passed at 2:34. Vaughn Harris made it 4-1 just 5 seconds later. Rebels Chris Attwood scored the eventual Game-Winning-Goal at 7:35 for a 5-1 lead. OLA Jr B Western Conference Rookie-of-the-Year, Jacob Bomberry, Carney Johnson, Danny Vyse would make it 8-1 before Brandon Montour made it 9-1 with 16 seconds left in the middle frame.

Six Nations outshot Welland 25-8 in the second frame.

The final period finished with the Rebels outscoring the Warlords 4-3 beginning with Carney Johnson netting his 2nd of the night at 9:30. Warlords Aaron Buswell made it 10-2 a couple of second pat the midway point of the third. Rebels Chris Attwood scored his second of the game just 25 seconds later. Vaughn Harris potted his 2nd of the night at 13:15 for a 12-2 Rebels lead. While Randy Martin (2nd of the game) finished the Rebels scoring off with 4:01 remaining. The Warlords got the final two goals as Jacob Dion and Scott Johnstone beat Rebels goalie H. Warren Hill in the final 3:49.

Welland outshot the Rebels 19-13 in the third, however Six Nations finished with 64-36 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by Jacob Bomberry with a five (1G, 4A) point night. Rebels game MVP Randy Martin (2G, 2A), Chris Attwood (2G, 2A) and Brandon Montour (2G, 2A) all finished with 4-points each. Vaughn Harris (2G, 1A) and Carney Johnson (2G, 1A) added three points apiece. Danny Vyse (1G, 1A), Joe Haodias Maracle (2A) and goalie H. Warren Hill (2A) netted a pair of points while single Rebels points were by Tony Doxtator (1G), captain Alex Martin (1A), Jacob Crans (1A), Dallas John (1A) and Jesse Jimerson (1A).

The Warlords were led by Brooke Muir (3A) had a three-point game. Single Welland points were by Corey Antongiovanni (1G), Aaron Buswell (1G), Jacob Dion (1G), Scott Johnstone (1G), Scott Pace (1A) and Joe Wormald (1A).

The Rebels will host the same Welland Warlords Friday night at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena for an 8:00 p.m. start.
