Six Nations Rebels 10 London Blue Devils 0

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels won their 5th consecutive game Sunday night with a 10-0 shutout of the London Blue Devils at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 597 lacrosse fans. The shutout was the 2nd in franchise history. The Rebels other shutout occurred back on June 4, 2000 when the Rebels shutout Guelph Regals 15-0. The Rebels also extended their consecutive regulations games without a loss during the regular season to 48-games back on April 28, 2007 in an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks.

The Rebels started netminder, Cody VanEvery in goal while Six Nations resident, Brennor Jacobs started for the Blue Devils.

The Rebels rookie, Kyle Isaacs got things going with the eventual game winner at 6:30 of the first period. Vaughn Harris made it 2-0 just 77 seconds later.

Six Nations outshot London 21-8 in the opening 20 minutes.

The Rebels continued to play strong defense while Jesse Johnson, Marty Hill and Kraig Maracle made it a 5-0 lead after 40 minutes of play.

Six Nations outshot London 22-6 in the middle frame.

In the third it was not whether or not the Rebels would win, but it would be whether or not the Rebels goalie, VanEvery would earn a shutout. The Rebels Ryley Johnson, Jeremy Johns (twice), Kraig Maracle (2nd of the game) and Kenny Aaron supplied the Rebels offense in the third period. The Rebels defense was up to the task as they limited the Blue Devils shots to just five in the third period as VanEvery completed the shutout.

Six Nations outshot London 20-5 in the third and 63-19 for the entire contest.

The Blue Devils would finish the night 0 of 3 on the power play while the Rebels were 1 for 4 with the extra man, but added one shorthanded goal.

The Rebels were led by their captain Marty Hill (1G, 3A) with a four-point game. Jeremy Johns added three (2G, 1A) points. Kraig Maracle (2G), Rebels Game MVP Jesse Johnson (1G, 1A), Vaughn Harris (1G, 1A), Kyle Isaacs (1G, 1A) and J. Quinn Powless (2A) enjoyed two-point games each. Single Rebels points were by Ryley Johnson (1G), Kenny Aaron (1G), Clark Robinson (1A), Johnny Powless (1A), Jesse Sault (1A), Rodd Squire (1A), Carney Johnson (1A) and goalie Cody VanEvery (1A).

The Blue Devils game MVP was goalie Brennor Jacobs as he made 53 saves in the Blue Devils loss.

The Rebels will be host the Hamilton Bengals Thursday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 p.m. start.

London will travel to the Elora Community Centre next Friday night for an 8:00 PM start against the Elora Mohawks.
