Six Nations Rebels 10 St. Catharines Spartan Warriors 7 (OT)

ST. CATHARINES - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels rebounded from their 1st loss Friday night to get back on their winning ways following a hard-fought 10-7 overtime triumph over the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors Sunday night at the Merritton Lions Arena before 300 fans. The Friday night Rebels loss snapped the regular season winning streak at 34-games as the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors scored an 8-6 overtime win over the Rebels. However, the Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks 44-games ago back on April 28, 2007.

The Rebels started Cody VanEvery in goal while Nate Barlow started for the Spartan Warriors.

The Rebels dominated the opening 20 minutes by building a 3-0 lead on the host Spartan Warriors on goals by Vaughn Harris, Kyle Isaacs and defensive specialist, Elijah Johns. Barlow kept his team in the game as the Rebels outshot his teammates 25-8 in the first period.

Spartan Warriors would get on the board 7:47 as Chris Attwood netted a power play marker. Rebels rookie, Johnny Powless connected with a power play goal of his own at 15:09 for a 4-1 Rebels lead. St. Catharines would a couple of late goals by Dillon Hendsbee and Attwood (2nd of the game) with 1.4 seconds left on the clock to cut the lead down to 4-3.

St. Catharines dominated the shot clock 21-8 in the middle frame.

In the third it looked like the Spartan Warriors were going to run away with the contest as Shane Dunkley would tie the game just two minutes in while Jake Ciaramella gave St. Catharines their first lead of the game. Rebels coaches opted to pull starter, VanEvery in favour of backup, Warren Hill after the Ciaramella goal at 5:51. VanEvery did not stay on the bench long as the Spartan Warriors Andrew D'Intino would score on their first shot on the new netminder just 21 seconds later for a 6-4 lead. Rebels coaches put VanEvery back in to guard the Six Nations net. Rebels Torrey VanEvery would get the club back to within one with a power play goal 85 seconds later. Kraig Maracle would tie the score at 6-6 all with 6:27 remaining. That is the way the teams would finish the third period.

Six Nations outshot St. Catharines 12-11 in the third.

The Rebels got the early bounce in the extra session as Vaughn Harris would be credited with his second of the game just 41 second into the 10-minute frame as he shot missed the net but bounced off the board and hit Spartan Warriors goalie, Barlow in the back of the leg to bounce into the net. Rebels rookie, J. Quinn Powless would score the eventual game winner at 2:53 and add another 4:01 for a 9-6 Rebels lead. Spartan Warriors game MVP, Chris Attwood would fire his hat-trick marker with 5:16 remaining, however the Rebels Game MVP, Jesse Johnson score into an empty net with six seconds showing on the clock to seal the victory.

The Rebels were led by Torrey VanEvery with a five-point (1G, 4A) game. Kraig Maracle (1G, 2A) and game MVP Jesse Johnson (1G, 2A) contributed with three-point games each. Vaughn Harris (2G), J. Quinn Powless (2G) and Kyle Isaacs (1G, 1A) all had two-point nights. Single Rebels points were by Elijah Johns (1G), Johnny Powless (1G), Jesse Staats (1A), Clark Robinson (1A), Jeremy Johns (1A), Randy E. Johnson (1A) and Pete Hill (1A).

Spartan Warriors were led by Game MVP Chris Attwood (3G, 1A) with a four-point game. Dillon Hendsbee (1G, 2A) and goalie Nate Barlow (3A) added three-points. Drew Thomas had a pair of helpers. Single Spartan Warriors points by Shane Dunkley (1G), Jake Ciaramella (1G), Andrew D'Intino (1G), Mike Melnychenko (1A) and Kyle Rushton (1A).

The Rebels travel Oakville Friday night to battle the Buzz at the Glen Abbey Rec Centre for an 8:00 p.m. start.

St. Catharines will host Orangeville Jr B Northmen Friday night at the Merritton Lions Arena for an 8:00 PM start.
