## Six Nations Rebels 11 Niagara Thunderhawks 7

**VIRGIL** - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels won their 32<sup>nd</sup> consecutive regular season game Sunday night before 261 lacrosse fans at the Meridian Credit Union Arena with an 11-7 win over the Niagara Thunderhawks. The winning streak dates back to a 12-11 overtime loss to Windsor AKO Fratmen on May 25, 2007. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks 40-games ago back on April 28, 2007.

The Rebels gave rookie netminder, Warren Hill his first start of his Jr B career while Julian Fauzey started for the Thunderhawks.

Hill make have let his nerves get to him as the Thunderhawks Bryson Phillipetti open the scoring just 15 seconds into the contest. Jake McCready gave the home team a 2-0 lead at 12:54. Alas all good things must come to an end at 14:50 as Rebels J. Quinn Powless was able to beat Thunderhawks goalie, Fauzey, who was perfect to that point. Another Rebels rookie, Kyle Isaacs netted his 1<sup>st</sup> career goal with a shorthanded effort at 17:31 to send the two teams to the 1<sup>st</sup> intermission knotted up at 2-2.

The Rebels outshot the Thunderhawks 23-15 in the first period.

Six Nations continued to pepper the Niagara net as Jeremy Johns scored on the Rebels 10<sup>th</sup> shot of the period just 4:05 into the middle stanza. However the Thunderhawks did not give as James Rickard scored the first of two second period power play goals at 7:50. Rebels veteran defender, Clark Robinson restored the lead at 9:22 and Jeremy Johns followed up with his second of the period at 12:57. The home team battled back to tie the game with Rickard scoring at 14:11 and Gaehnew:rawen Printup at 15:42 made it a 5-5 game. Rebels eventual game MVP, Kraig Maracle would give the visitors a 6-5 lead heading to the 2<sup>nd</sup> intermission.

Six Nations outshot Niagara 27-10 in the middle frame.

Niagara would tie the game at 4:26 as Printup fired home his second of the game. However former Thunderhawks Kenny Aaron would give the Rebels a lead they would not relinquish with a breakaway marker at 7:42. Alex Kedoh Hill would follow that up with a power play goal at 10:49. Again the Thunderhawks threatened the Rebels as Lloyd Chrysler beat Hill for a 8-7 score with 7:42 remaining on the clock. Six Nations would get goals from Maracle and Kedoh Hill only 63 seconds apart to seal the Rebels 3<sup>rd</sup> victory of the 2009 season. Rebels' rookie, Johnny Powless was able to add his 1<sup>st</sup> career goal with 2:51 remaining to round out the scoring.

Six Nations outshot Niagara 20-11 in the third to finish with 70-36 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by Kraig Maracle (2G, 1A), Alex Kedoh Hill (2G, 1A), J. Quinn Powless (1G, 2A), Kyle Isaacs (1G, 2A) and defensive standout, Elijah Johns (3A) all finished with three points each. Jeremy Johns (2G) and Johnny Powless (1G, 1A) had a pair of points. Single Rebels points were by Clark Robinson (1G), Kenny Aaron (1G), Rebels captain Marty Hill (1A), Torrey VanEvery (1A), Vaughn Harris (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A) and goalie Warren Hill (1A).

The Thunderhawks were led by game MVP Corey Fowler with five helpers. Gaehnew:rawen Printup added three points (2G, 1A). James Rickard (2G), Jake McCready (1G, 1A) and Josh Kilgour (2A) contributed two points each. Single Niagara points were by Bryson Phillipetti (1G), Lloyd Chrysler (1G), Don Ferguson (1A), Brendon Johnston (1A) and Marcus Lagerstrom (1A).

The Rebels will host Orangeville Jr B Northmen Friday night for an 8:00 p.m. start at the Gaylord Powless Arena in Ohsweken.

Niagara will host Welland Warlords at the Niagara Meridian Credit Union Arena Thursday night for a 7:30 PM.
