Six Nations Rebels 12 Niagara Thunderhawks 3

OHSWEKEN - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels look forward to the real season to begin next Friday night. However the Rebels needed to finish off the 2009 Regular season as they thumped the Niagara Thunderhawks 12-3 Sunday night 307 lacrosse fans at the Gaylord Powless Arena. The Rebels led the OLA Jr B circuit with over 5,000 lacrosse fans attending the 10 regular season contests held on the Six Nations of the Grand River Territory. The win clinched 1st Place in the South West Division for the Rebels moving 2 points up on the idle Welland Warlords, however the Rebels have the tie-breaker over Welland. The Warlords host the Thunderhawks Tuesday night at the Welland Arena. After the other games were settled Sunday night, the Rebels were seeded 3rd according to the OLA Rules and Regulations. The Rebels finished in a tie (27 Pts) with the Elora Mohawks, however, the Rebels had 13 wins during the regular while the Mohawks had 12 wins. Despite this, the OLA uses the head-to-head as the 1st tie-breaker to give the Mohawks the # 2 seed and the Rebels # 3 seed.

OLA Western Conference Playoffs have # 1-Windsor AKO Fratmen vs # 8-Owen Sound NorthStars; # 2-Elora Mohawks vs # 7-St. Catharines Spartan Warriors; # 3-Six Nations Rebels vs # 6-Oakville Buzz; # 4-Guelph Regals vs # 5-Welland Warlords. Welland can still grab # 4 seed and home-floor advantage with a win in their season finale against the Niagara Thunderhawks Tuesday night in Welland.

The Rebels started Warren Hill in goal while Cory Henry started for the Thunderhawks.

The Rebels All-Star representative and Western Conference Game MVP, Kraig Maracle opened the scoring just 42 seconds into the contest with a power play marker. Ryley Johnson up the Rebels up 2-0 at 7:25 only to have Thunderhawks Tom Owen cut the lead in half 68 seconds later. Maracle added his second of the game six seconds past the half way point of the 1st period only to have the Thunderhawks Chad Leadingfox and Mike White tie the score 3-3 in an 18 seconds span.

Six Nations outshot Niagara 23-10 in the opening 20 minutes.

Rebels Wayne VanEvery would net the eventual game-winning goal at 1:33 of the middle frame. Rebels rookie, Vaughn Harris extended the lead to 5-3. Another outstanding rookie, J. Quinn Powless grabbed a rebound off the boards and promptly deposited the ball behind Thunderhawks goalie, Henry with 4 minutes left on the clock. Maracle completed his hat-trick with a shorthanded goal late in the second period for a 7-3 Six Nations lead after 40 minutes of play.

Six Nations outshot Niagara 25-12 in the middle frame.

At the start of the third period, the Thunderhawks sat starter, Henry down in favour of Julian Fauzey. The move did not slow down the Rebels shooters as Jeremy Johns made it 8-3 at the 5:59 mark. Jesse Johnson added a shorthanded goal at 15:34. Newcomer, Chadd Murphy netted his first goal in a Rebels uniform at 16:06 while Carney Johnson deposited a power play goal 52 seconds later for an 11-3 lead. It would Rebels rookie, Kyle Isaacs rounding out the 2009 OLA Jr B regular season scoring with a shorthanded goal with 54 seconds remaining in the contest.

Six Nations outshot Niagara 15-11 in the third to hold a 63-33 edge for the entire contest.

The Thunderhawks would finish the night 0 of 4 on the power play advantages while the Rebels were 2 for 4 with three shorthanded markers on the night.

The Rebels were led by their OLA Jr B Western Conference game MVP, Kraig Maracle with a added four point (3G, 1A) game. Rebels Game MVP, J. Quinn Powless (1G, 2A) and Wayne VanEvery (1G, 2A) finished with three point games each. Chadd Murphy (1G, 1A), Ryley Johnson (1G, 1A), Carney Johnson (1G, 1A), Vaughn Harris (1G, 1A), Jeremy Johns (1G, 1A) and Rodd Squire (2A) all had two-point nights. Single Rebels points were by Jesse Johnson (1G), Kyle Isaacs (1G), Russell Longboat (1A), Kenny Aaron (1A), G. Dylan Johnson (1A), Danny Vyse (1A) and goalie Warren Hill (1A).

The Thunderhawks game MVP was defender David Evert while single Thunderhawks points were by Tom Owen (1G), Chad Leadingfox (1G), Mike White (1G), Jake McCready (1A), Matt Friesen (1A) and Wesley Dillon (1A).

The Rebels will begin the 2009 Post-season action this Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena for an 8:00 p.m. start against the # 6-seed, Oakville Buzz. The remaining playoff schedule as yet to be set.

Niagara travel to Welland for their season finale Tuesday night at the Welland Arena against the Warlords.
