Six Nations Rebels 14 Hamilton Bengals 5

SIX NATIONS - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels extended their current winning streak to 6-games with a 14-5 win over the Hamilton Bengals Thursday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 485 lacrosse fans. The Rebels also extended their consecutive regulations games without a loss during the regular season to 49-games back on April 28, 2007 in an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks.

The Rebels started rookie netminder, Warren Hill in goal while John McNamara started for the Bengals.

The Rebels Jesse Sault got things going just 48 seconds into the first period. The Bengals Shawn Stringer evened the score at 5:17.

The Rebels would go on a 6-goal scoring spree with captain Marty Hill notching a hat-trick, Kraig Maracle scored twice and Kenny Aaron would score the eventual game-winner for 7-1 Rebels lead after 20 minutes of play.

Six Nations outshot Hamilton 22-10 in the opening 20 minutes.

Hamilton would score the first 3 goals of the second as captain Joey Cupido (25th of the season), Marcus Tansley and Brent Longboat would cut the lead to 7-4 by the 5:30 mark. But that would be all the offense from the Bengals in the middle period as Kyle Isaacs would score a shorthanded marker with 5:29 left in the middle frame while Alex Kedoh Hill extend the Rebels lead to 9-4 after 40 minutes of play.

Six Nations outshot Hamilton 17-16 in the middle frame.

In the third at 1:18, Jesse Staats netted his first goal; as a Rebels, after coming over from Hamilton in a pre-season deal. Jesse Johnson made it 11-4 at 4:40 while Brent Longboat cut the lead down to 11-5 midway through the third. Alex Kedoh Hill (2nd of the game), Kyle Isaacs (2nd of the game) and Marty Hill (4th of the game) finished of the Rebels highest offensive output of the season.

Six Nations outshot Hamilton 22-12 in the third and 61-38 for the entire contest.

The Bengals would finish the night 0 of 1 on the power play while the Rebels did not have an opportunity with the extra man, but added the one shorthanded goal.

The Rebels were led by their Game MVP Kraig Maracle with a six-point (2G, 4A) night. Team captain Marty Hill (4G, 1A) and Alex Kedoh Hill had five-point games each. Rookie Kyle Isaacs added four-points (2G, 2A). Jesse Johnson contributed three-points (1G, 2A) points on the night. Jesse Sault (1G, 1A), Jesse Staats (1G, 1A), Kenny Aaron (1G, 1A), Johnson Jimerson (2A) and goalie Warren Hill (2A) enjoyed two-point games apiece. Single Rebels assists were by Jeremy Johns, Jason Johns and Russell Longboat (1A).

The Bengals were led by their Game MVP Brent Longboat (2G, 1A) and captain Joey Cupido (1G, 2A) with three point games each. Shawn Stringer (1G, 1A) and Zach Hill (2A) had two-point games apiece. Single Bengals points were by Marcus Tansley (1G), Mitchell Iszkula (1A), Ryan Ames (1A) and Patrick Root (1A).

The Rebels will travel on Friday night to the Clearwater Arena to battle the Far West Division, Sarnia Pacers for an 8:00 p.m. start.

Hamilton will travel to the Glen Abbey Rec Centre to faceoff against the Oakville Buzz Friday night for an 8:00 PM start.
