Six Nations Rebels 23 Mississauga Tomahawks 2 (Exhibition)

SIX NATIONS – The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels looked like a force to be reckoned with as they defeated the Mississauga Jr B Tomahawks 23-2 Sunday night at the Iroquois Lacrosse Arena before more than 500 lacrosse fans. The Rebels donated the admission gate to the Six Nations Minor Lacrosse Association.

With the Rebels going 20-and-0 during the 2008 regular and the Tomahawks finishing with a 1-18-and-1 record; on paper the outcome should have never been in doubt. The outcome met expectations.

Gavin Lecky started in goal for the Tomahawks while Rebels hopeful rookie, Warren Hill got the start for the home team. The Rebels began the game by taking the first 9 shots on goal, however it would be Jamie Speck give the Tomahawks the early lead at the 7:14 mark. The Rebels' Jesse Staats would reply 43 seconds to get the offense going as Jeremy Johns connected just 28 seconds later to give them their first lead of the game. The Tomahawks Andrew Miller notched the game at deuces midway through the first period. Nonetheless it would be the last goal of the game for the Tomahawks. Jesse Sault would net the eventual game winner at 12:29 and Jeremy Johns would mesh his 2nd of the game as the Rebels would lead 4-2 after 20 minutes of action.

The Rebels outshot the Tomahawks 18-11 in the first period.

In the second period, the Rebels opened the flood gates with a 13-goal outburst. Rebels' captain, Marty Hill led the way by scoring four times. Alex Kedoh Hill, Kraig Maracle and Kyle Isaacs all scored twice each in the middle frame. Johnny Powless, Jeremy Johns (3rd of the game) and Vaughn Harris added singles in the 2nd period. The Rebels changed goalies as Don Alton took over for Warren Hill at 7:43 of the second period while Josh Udall took over the Tomahawks cage at 8:49.

Six Nations outshot Mississauga 27-3 in the second session.

In the third, Rebels Johnny Powless scored twice to complete his hat-trick while single markers were by Alex Kedoh Hill (3rd of the game), Kyle Isaacs (3rd of the game), Kenny Aaron and Quinn Powless.

Six Nations outshot Mississauga 15-5 in the third to finish with 60-17 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by rookie Johnny Powless and Alex Kedoh Hill with 7-points (3G, 4A) each on the night. Rebels captain Marty Hill (4G, 2A), Jeremy Johns (3G, 3A) and Quinn Powless (1G, 5A) all had six-point nights each. Kraig Maracle added five-points (2G, 3A). Vaughn Harris (1G, 3A) netted four-points. Kyle Isaacs (3G) and Jesse Johnson (3A) all contributed three-points. Jesse Sault finished with a two-point (1G, 1A) night. Single Rebels points were by Jesse Staats (1G), Kenny Aaron (1G), Randy Martin (1A) and Jason Johns (1A).

The Tomahawks single points were by Jamie Speck (1G), Andrew Miller (1G) and Breyden Curron (1A).

The Rebels officially begin their defense of Back-2-Back Founders Cup championships when they travel to Wallaceburg Memorial Arena Friday night to open the 2009 OLA Jr B schedule against the Wallaceburg Red Devils for an 8:30 p.m. start.

While Mississauga will host the Guelph Regals at the Clarkson Arena Tuesday night at 9:00 PM in their last exhibition game before the regular season commences.
