Six Nations Rebels 5 Hamilton Bengals 3

HAMILTON - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels ended a 3-game winless skid with a 5-3 win over the Hamilton Bengals Sunday night at the Dave Andreychuk Arena before 175 lacrosse fans. The Rebels started netminder, Cody VanEvery in goal while Matt Oddi started for the Bengals.

The Rebels Kraig Maracle opened the scoring with a power play marker just 83 seconds into the contest. Rebels' Midget rookie call up, J. Quinn Powless made it 2-0 before the game was five minutes old. Former Rebels player, Zach Hill got the benefit of a good bounce of an errant shot that hit Rebels goalie VanEvery in the back of his foot and trickle of the goal line for a 2-1 score after 20 minutes of play.

The win lifts the Rebels into a 2nd-place tie with the Welland Warlords for the South West Division title with 23 points each with each team having two games remaining in the regular season. St. Catharines Spartan Warriors took over the division lead with 24 points after they defeated the Oakville Buzz 5-3 Sunday night at the Merrittion Lions Arena.

Six Nations outshot Hamilton 16-12 in the opening 20 minutes.

The Rebels Ryley Johnson made it 3-1 prior to the half way point of the contest. Jeremy Johns would fire home the eventual game winning goal at the 12:45 mark of the second period. Hamilton would cut the lead in half as Hill caught VanEvery off guard with a shot outside the hockey blue at the 13:11 mark. Ryley Johnson would make it 5-2 a little over a minute later.

Hamilton outshot the visitors 19-14 in the middle frame.

In the third at 1:18, Aaron Buswell would net a power play goal in the final minute of the contest which turned out to be the only goal of the third period to round out the scoring.

Six Nations outshot Hamilton 15-12 in the third and 45-43 for the entire contest.

The Bengals would finish the night 1 of 7 on the power play while the Rebels were 1 for 4 with the extra man.

The Rebels were led by their Game MVP Kraig Maracle (1G, 2A) and Jeremy Johns (1G, 2A) with a three-point night apiece. Ryley Johnson (2G), J. Quinn Powless (1G, 1A) and Jesse Johnson (2A) enjoyed two-point games each. Single Rebels assists were by Kenny Aaron (1A) and Jesse Staats (1A).

The Bengals were led by their Game MVP Zach Hill (2G, 1A) with a three-point game. Aaron Buswell (1G, 1A) contributed a two-point game. Single Bengals points were by Kyle Parsons (1A), Mitchell Iszkula (1A) and Shawn Stringer (1A).

The Rebels will host South West Division rival, Oakville Buzz Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena with an 8:00 p.m. start.

Hamilton will host Wallaceburg Red Devils Friday night at the Dave Andreychuk Arena with an 8:00 PM start.
