## Six Nations Rebels 8 Sarnia Pacers 1

**SIX NATIONS** - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels extended their current winning streak to 7-games with an 8-1 win over the Sarnia Pacers Friday night at the Clearwater Arena before 253 lacrosse fans. The Rebels also extended their consecutive regulations games without a loss during the regular season to 50-games back on April 28, 2007 in an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks.

The Rebels started rookie netminder, Warren Hill in goal while Justin Matthews started for the Pacers.

The Pacers got the early jump on the Rebels with T. J. Mara opening the scoring just 21 seconds into the contest on their first shot of the game. However, that would be the only shot to elude Rebels Game MVP, Warren Hill the rest of the night. Rookie Vaughn Harris would tie the score at 2:16. Another Rebels rookie, Kyle Isaacs would score what would turn out to be the eventual game-winning-goal just 24 seconds later for a 2-1 Rebels lead. Jeremy Johns would add a power play goal at 9:43, while rookie Randy Martin scored his 1<sup>st</sup> Jr B goal of his young career at the 12:04 mark. Just when both teams looked content on going to the dressing room with the score of 4-1, rookie J. Quinn Powless would find the back of the net with 4.3 seconds show on the clock.

Six Nations outshot Sarnia 21-8 in the opening 20 minutes.

Rebels defensive standout Clark Robinson made it 6-1 at 7:41. Then captain, Marty Hill killed off more than 30 seconds before breaking free to find himself all alone in front of the Pacers goal to score a shorthanded marker at 8:51. Vaughn Harris would net his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the game with 3:20 left on the clock for what would turn out to be the final official goal of the game.

Six Nations outshot Sarnia 17-9 in the middle frame.

In the third at 2:10, the appeared to have scored their 9<sup>th</sup> goal of the game as Pacers goalie, Bob Smith (replace starter Matthews at start of third period) fumbled an attempted clearing pass only to have it land in the stick of J. Quinn Powless who easily deposited the ball into the open Pacers net. However, neither referee signaled the goal and the play continued on. There would be a number of good chances for both squads but no one would find the back of the net the rest of the contest.

Six Nations outshot Sarnia 14-12 in the third and 52-29 for the entire contest.

The Pacers would finish the night 0 of 4 on the power play while the Rebels were 2 of 3 with the extra man, also added the one shorthanded goal.

The Rebels were led by Jeremy Johns with a four-point (1G, 3A) night. Vaughn Harris (2G), Kyle Isaacs (1G, 1A), Clark Robinson (1G, 1A), captain Marty Hill (1G, 1A) and Rodd Squire (2A) enjoyed two-point games apiece. Single Rebels points were by Randy Martin (1G), J. Quinn Powless (1G), Jason Johns (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A) and Alex Kedoh Hill (1A). Goalie Warren Hill was named Rebels Game MVP while making 28 saves on the night.

The Pacers points were by T. J. Mara (1G), Dan Charlton (1A) and Jim Purves (1A). Pacers Game MVP was to Lance Ross.

The Rebels will travel on Sunday night to the Glen Abbey Rec Centre to battle the South West Division rivals' Oakville Buzz for a 7:00 p.m. start.

Sarnia will host the Elora Mohawks at 3:00 PM Sunday afternoon at the Clearwater Arena.
