## Six Nations Rebels 8 Welland Warlords 5

**OHSWEKEN** - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels celebrated the 2008 season with a pre-game Founders Cup Championship Ring ceremony Friday night before 698 lacrosse fans at the Gaylord Powless Arena. After the banners were unfurled, the Rebels extended their current regular season winning streak to 31-games with an 8-5 over the visiting Welland Warlords. The winning streak dates back to a 12-11 overtime loss to Windsor AKO Fratmen on May 25, 2007. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks 39-games ago back on April 28, 2007.

Warlords started the 2008 OLA Jr B Western Conference Rookie-of-the-year, Connor Danko while Cody VanEvery got the start in goal for the Rebels.

Six Nations got off to the quick start as Kraig Maracle opened the scoring just 19 seconds into the contest and Alex Kedoh Hill made it 2-0 just 46 seconds later. The Warlords promptly replaced starter Connor and replace him with back-up goalie Graeme Kirkness. However, Kirkness was unable to stop the Rebels onslaught as without delay Torrey VanEvery made it 3-0 just 7 seconds later. Randy E. Johnson upped the score to 4-0 at 6:23 and Alex Kedoh Hill made it 5-0 at 7:02.

Welland replaced goalies again at this point; as Kirkness was out and Danko was back in. Kirkness faced 7 shots during his 5:57 of action while allowing three goals. Welland finally stopped the bleeding and got on the scoreboard with a power play goal by Mac Abbott while Rebels captain, Marty Hill scored what would turn out to be the eventual game winner at 14:32.

The Rebels outshot the Warlords 15-11 in the first period.

The second period had both defenses dominate much of the 20-minute session until Rebels Kraig Maracle made it 7-1 at 10:32. Welland began to gain some momentum as Kevin Floris scored a shorthand marker at 17:10. Warlords captain, Steve McIlwrath scored twice just 14 seconds apart in the final minute of play to cut the Rebels lead down to 7-4 after 40-minutes of play.

Both teams fired 13 shots each in the middle frame.

Both team defenses continued to dominate the game with Warlords Mac Abbott was credited with a strange bouncing ball could not be corralled by three different Rebels defenders and eventual made it over the shoulder of Rebels goalie, VanEvery for Welland's final goal of the game. The Rebels' Torrey VanEvery notched the final goal of the contest at 8:40. Six Nations outshot Welland 19-8 in the third to finish with 47-32 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by Torrey VanEvery (2G, 1A) and Alex Kedoh Hill (2G, 1A) with three points each. Kraig Maracle (2G), Marty Hill (1G, 1A), Johnny Powless (2A) and Kenny Aaron (2A) all had a pair of points. Single Rebels points were by Randy E. Johnson (1G), Quinn Powless (1A), Clark Robinson (1A) and Jeremy Johns (1A). Rebels defensive standout, Pete Hill was the Rebels game MVP.

The Warlords were led by captain, Steve McIlwrath (2G, 1A) and Jordy Daradick (3A) had three-point games. Welland game MVP MacKenzie Abbott had two goals on the night.

The Rebels will travel to the Niagara Credit Union Arena in Virgil Sunday night when they are hosted by the Niagara Thunderhawks for a 7:00 p.m. start.

Welland will host Elora Mohawks at the Welland Memorial Arena Sunday afternoon at 3:00 PM.
