Six Nations Rebels 9 Oakville Buzz 8 (OT)

OAKVILLE - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels over came a 7-4 third period deficit to score a come-from-behind 9-8 overtime win over the Oakville Buzz Friday night at the Glen Abbey Recreation Centre. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks 45-games ago back on April 28, 2007.

The Rebels started rookie netminder, Warren Hill in goal while Cam Watts started for the Buzz.

The Rebels Ryley Johnson got things going at 1:53 into the action. The Buzz Alex Kruse tied the game with a power play marker at 4:28 and Mike Dawson gave the home team a 2-1 lead 86 seconds later. Rebels Kraig Maracle tied the game at the 11:17 mark and Jeremy Johns gave Six Nations a 3-2 after 20 minutes of play. The Rebels have lost the services of Founders Cup All-star defender, Elijah Johns for the next 6 to 8 weeks with a broken leg after a collision with a Buzz player late in the first period.

Both teams fired 9 shots on net in the opening period.

The second period belonged to the Buzz as the would net a hat-trick of extra-man advantage goals (Justin Beatty, Connor Gamble and Spencer Gallant) plus a pair of even-strength goals by Dawson and Gamble to build a 7-3 lead late in the second period. However, the Rebels Jeremy Johns would score late in the middle session for 7-4 Buzz lead at the end of 40 minutes of play.

Oakville out shot Six Nations 12-10 in the middle frame.

In the third, Six Nations got the important first goal of the third period as Jeremy Johns completed his hat-trick at 2:20. Rebels captain, Marty Hill cut the lead down to one at 16:51 and would tie the score 57 seconds later to force the overtime. Rebels rookie, Kyle Isaacs was checked from behind on a breakaway by the Buzz Alex Kruse with 1:31 left in regulation time to receive a 5-minute Major and a game misconduct to put the Rebels on the power play heading into the overtime. Isaacs would not return to action the remainder of the contest.

Six Nations outshot Oakville 20-11 in the third.

Kenny Aaron put the Rebels up 8-7 with a breakaway power play marker at 1:46 into the 10-minute overtime period. The Buzz Jamie Elliott tied to the score at 6:01 to set the stage for Rebels Jeremy Johns who would clinch his Game MVP honours with his 4th goal of the game to complete the Rebels come-back with just 30 seconds showing on the clock.

The Rebels held a 7-3 edge in shots during the third period and a 47-34 edge for the entire contest.

The Buzz would finish the night 4 of 8 on the power play while the Rebels were 1 for 3 with the extra man.

The Rebels were led by their Game MVP Jeremy Johns (4G) with a four goal game. Rebels captain Marty Hill added three (2G, 1A) points on the night. Kraig Maracle (1G, 1A), Ryley Johnson (1G, 1A), Jason Johns (2A) and Rodd Squire (2A) enjoyed two-point games. Single Rebels points were by Kenny Aaron (1G), Jesse Staats (1A), Clark Robinson (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A), Vaughn Harris (1A) and Jesse Sault (1A).

The Buzz were led by Mike Dawson with a 6-point (2G, 4A) game. Buzz Game MVP Connor Gamble contributed three (2G, 1A) points. Alex Kruse (1G, 1A) and Spencer Allen (1G, 1A) had two-point games each. Single Buzz points were by Justin Beatty (1G), Jamie Elliott (1G) and Mark White (1A).

The Rebels will host two former teammates in Zach Hill and Brent Longboat Sunday night when they host the Hamilton Bengals for an 7:00 p.m. start.

Oakville will travel to Orangeville to play the Jr B Northmen Saturday night at the Tony Rose Arena for a 7:00 PM start.
