Six Nations Rebels 9 Wallaceburg Red Devils 4

WALLACEBURG - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels kicked off the 2009 OLA Jr B season with a 9-4 Friday night at the Wallaceburg Memorial Arena. The Rebels win extends their current regular season winning streak to 30-games, dating back to a 12-11 overtime loss to Windsor AKO Fratmen on May 25, 2007. The Rebels last regulation game loss during the regular season was an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks 38-games ago back on April 28, 2007.

The Rebels went 20-and-0 during the 2008 regular and knocked the Red Devils out of the post-season with a three-game sweep in the opening round of the Ontario Lacrosse Association Jr B League playoffs.

Rookie Midget AP, goalie Don Alton got the start in goal for the Rebels while Tye Belanger got the start in the Red Devils net.

Six Nations got off to the quick start as another rookie Midget AP, Quinn Powless opened the scoring at 2:06 which was followed by 2009 Rebels captain, Marty Hill with first of the year at 4:50. The Red Devils were able to bounce back with Zack Underwood and Red Devils captain, Kyle VanDamme to tie the game by 8:41. Rebels coach gave goalie Alton a quick timeout as he put, backup goalie, Cody VanEvery in the goal for 2:01. At that point, Rebels Founders Cup All-star defender, Elijah Johns netted his first of the young season. Randy E. Johnson followed with his first of the year for a 4-2 lead after 20 minutes.

The Rebels outshot the Red Devils 19-7 in the first period.

The second period witnessed the Rebels being shutout for a 20-minute session by Red Devils goalie, Belanger as he stopped all 12 shots he faced while teammate, Reid Miller added a power play marker to make it 4-3 after 40-minutes of play.

Six Nations outshot Wallaceburg 12-10 in the second session.

In the third, Rebels offense soon end the shutout streak as captain Hill fired his 2nd of the game at 2:35 (eventual game winner) and Quinn Powless (2nd of the game) scored at 4:19 for a quick 6-3 lead. Clint Lamarsh cut the lead back with the Red Devils final goal of the game at 5:49. Rebels 3rd year veteran, Torrey VanEvery made it 7-4 at 8:39 while Kenny Aaron and Marty Hill (3rd of the game) round out the scoring.

Six Nations outshot Wallaceburg 26-6 in the third to finish with 57-23 edge in shots on the night.

The Rebels were led by captain Marty Hill (3G, 1A) with four points. Rookie Quinn Powless (2G, 1A) and Kenny Aaron (1G, 2A) had three-point nights each. Elijah Johns (1G, 1A) and Jeremy Johns (2A) contributed a pair of points on the night while single Rebels points were by Randy E. Johnson (1G), Torrey VanEvery (1G), Pete Hill (1A), Rodd Squire (1A), Kraig Maracle (1A), Jesse Johnson (1A) and goalie Don Alton (1A).

The Red Devils were led by Chad Murphy (1G, 1A) and Brandon Lilley (2A) with two-points each. Single Red Devils points were by captain Kyle VanDamme (1G), Reid Miller (1G), Clint Lamarsh (1G), Shane Pollock (1A) and Rob Pollock (1A).

The Rebels will unveil their 2008 J.A. MacDonald Trophy and Founders Cup banners along with distribution of championship rings at their home opener Friday night when they host the Welland Warlords for an 8:00 p.m. start. While Wallaceburg will host the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors at the Wallaceburg Memorial Arena a week Sunday afternoon at 2:00 PM.

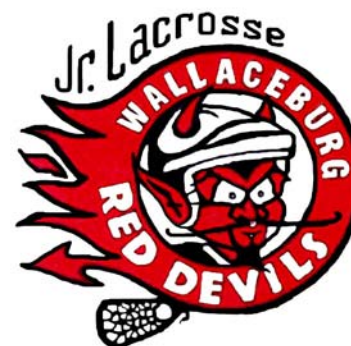
