## Six Nations Rebels 9 Welland Warlords 7

**SIX NATIONS** - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels won their 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive game as they defeated the Welland Warlords 9-7 Friday night at the Welland Arena before 578 lacrosse fans. The Rebels extended their consecutive regulations games without a loss during the regular season to 46-games back on April 28, 2007 in an 11-10 loss to Niagara Thunderhawks.

The Rebels started netminder, Cody VanEvery in goal while Graeme Kirkness started for the Warlords.

The Rebels grabbed a 3-0 after the first 20-minutes as Kenny Aaron, Jesse Sault and Jesse Johnson all got a shot past Warlords goalie, Kirkness.

Six Nations outshot Welland 19-10 in the opening 20 minutes.

A couple of Rebels rookie players, Carney Johnson (1<sup>st</sup> Jr B goal of his career) and Kyle Isaacs, would extend their lead to 5-0 during the second period. However, off of a Rebels timeout with 24.9 seconds on the clock, the visitors tried to set up a last second shot on the Warlords goal. An errant pass to the Rebels player coming off the bench soon gave Warlords speedster, Jordy Daradick with an open net. It would be a bang-bang play, however referees Jeramie Bailey and Chris Williams indicated the ball cross the goal line before the end of the second period buzzer sounded for a 5-1 Rebels lead after 40-minutes of action.

Six Nations outshot Welland 16-13 in the middle frame.

In the third, Welland used the momentum of scoring in the final seconds to start the third period as they would get goals from Mackenzie Abbott, Tyler Warren and Ryan Dakin made it 5-4 by the 6:52 mark. Rebels coach staff relieved starter, VanEvery in favour of rookie netminder Warren Hill at that point. However less than two minutes later, Tyler Tanguay would tie the contest 5-5 at the 8:40 mark of the third. Rebels goalie, VanEvery re-entered the game at this point. The Rebels Kraig Maracle was able to stop the bleeding with his 11<sup>th</sup> goal of the season at 10:02. Rookie J. Quinn Powless made it a 2-goal game a couple of minutes later. Rebels captain Marty Hill would fire home the eventual game winner at 14:40 for an 8-5 lead. Warlords captain, Kevin Floris cut the lead down with 3:55 to go in regulation. With the home team pressing and pulling their goalie to narrow the gap again, Rebels Kenny Aaron would race down the floor to beat Kirkness before he had a chance to get set in his net for a 9-6 lead with 2:33 showing on the clock.

Warlords Mac Abbott with his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the period would finish off the scoring with 1:21 remaining.

Welland outshot Six Nations 15-13 in the third but were outshot 48-38 for the entire contest.

Neither team was able to get a power play marker with only 7 minutes each in penalties called on both squads.

The Rebels were led by their captain Marty Hill (1G, 3A) with a four-point game. Carney Johnson contributed three-points (1G, 2A) points on the night. Kenny Aaron (2G), Kyle Isaacs (1G, 1A) and Jesse Johnson (1G, 1A) enjoyed two-point games each. Single Rebels points were by Jesse Sault (1G), Kraig Maracle (1G), J. Quinn Powless (1G), Jeremy Johns (1A), Jesse Staats (1A), G. Dylan Johnson (1A), Rodd Squire (1A) and goalie, Cody VanEvery (1A).

The Warlords were led by MacKenzie Abbott (2G, 1A), Jordy Daradick (1G, 2A) and game MVP Tyler Warren (1G, 2A) with three-point games each. Warlords captain Kevin Floris and Tyler Tanguay had two-point (1G, 1A) games. Single Warlords points were by Ryan Dakin (1G), and Dylan Gatt (1A).

The Rebels will be home Sunday night when they host the Far West Division rivals, London Blue Devils at the Gaylord Powless Arena for a 7:00 p.m. start.

Welland will travel north to St. Catharines Sunday night to battle the Spartan Warriors at the Merritton Lions Arena for a 7:00 PM start.
