St. Catharines Spartan Warriors 6 Six Nations Rebels 5

OHSWEKEN - The 3-time and current Back-2-Back Founders Cup and J.A. MacDonald Trophy champions, Six Nations Rebels suffered a hard-fought 6-5 loss to the St. Catharines Spartan Warriors Friday night at the Gaylord Powless Arena before 460 lacrosse fans. The ended the Rebels consecutive game streak without a regulation loss at 52-games dating back to April 28, 2007 when Niagara Thunderhawks edged the Rebels 11-10.

The Rebels started Warren Hill in goal while Nate Barlow started for the Spartan Warriors.

The Rebels dominated the opening 20 minutes by outshooting the Spartan Warriors 18-9 however, the teams would be tied 1-1 after 20 minutes as Sean Frankland scored for St. Catharines while Rodd Squire notched his first career Jr B goal for Six Nations.

The Rebels jump out to a 4-1 lead in the first 4:33 on goals by Alex Kedoh Hill, Ryley Johnson and captain Marty Hill. Spartan Warriors would get one back by T. J. Buck at 13:06. Kedoh Hill made it 5-2 just 31 seconds later and it would be last goal Spartan Warriors goalie, Barlow would give up the rest of the night. Mike Melnychenko cut the lead to 5-3 just 21 seconds later. Frankland added his 2nd of the game with a power play marker 15:55 as the two team would head to the second intermission with the Rebels holding a 5-4 lead.

The Rebels outshot the Spartan Warriors 19-15 in the middle frame.

In the third it looked like things might be going in the Rebels favour as Spartan Warriors were given their 1st minor penalty of the contest at 5:07. However after numerous opportunity were turned away, Chris Attwood was sent on a breakaway to tie the game with a shorthanded effort at 6:36. It would be Attwood netting the eventual game winner midway through the third. The Rebels pressed and looked to have scored a couple of times only to have crease violations called against them.

Six Nations outshot St. Catharines 20-12 in the third and 57-36 for the entire contest.

Spartan Warriors goalie, Nate Barlow earned the game MVP honours with his 52 save performance or a .912 save % on the night. The Rebels 2009 All-star representative, Clark Robinson was their game MVP.

Joining Robinson at the 2009 Jr B All-Star game will be Rebels offensive righty, Kraig Maracle and goalie, Cody VanEvery.

The Rebels were led by Alex Kedoh Hill (2G), captain Marty Hill (1G, 1A) and Kraig Maracle (2A) with two-point games each. Single Rebels points were by Rodd Squire (1G), Ryley Johnson (1G), Danny Vyse (1A), Jake Bomberry (1A), Russell Longboat (1A) and Jeremy Johns (1A).

Spartan Warriors were led by Chris Attwood (2G, 1A) with a three-point game. Sean Frankland (2G), T. J. Buck (1G, 1A), Dillon Hendsbee (2A) and Adam Dickson (2A) a pair of points each. Single Spartan Warriors points by Mike Melnychenko (1G), Shane Dunkley (1A) and Brett Stolar (1A).

The Rebels travel Owen Sound Sunday afternoon to battle the NorthStars at the Harry Lumley Bayshore Arena for a 2:00 p.m. start. St. Catharines will host Niagara Thunderhawks Sunday night at the Merritton Lions Arena for a 7:00 PM start.
